

RK Diary Travel 1903 Pp 42-43 Diary #1

..be out there again. Such crowds of people out on the streets here tonight the whole street is full. Had five in to see me today and I think most of them will go out.

Feb. 8. The ink has run out in my fountain pen and I can't get it filled until tomorrow. I have just come back from church, the old parish church of Dudley (?) I don't know its name or the name of the man who spoke. Went to church again tonight to another church a good crowd there. In afternoon went to see the ground and ruins of Dudley castle. Part of the walls of the old place left it was destroyed in Cromwell's time and is a fine old ruin. I went up into the town and could see the whole country all around it is tall chimneys. All over and hardly anything else to be seen lots of manufacturing here.

Feb. 9. Left Dudley at 8:13 this morning for Eveshaw at Stornbridge junction we left the tall chimneys and all the way to Worcester it is a fine farming and fruit raising district. I am now writing at Worcester Station and understand I have to change cars again before getting to Eveshaw. Today is grey and dull, also a little cold.
