Thurs Aug 4: A beautiful day - bright & cool with east wind. Started cutting at 10 to seven this morning this morning but broke packer crank at 10.30 A.M. & had to go to town in car (took Muriel along) & got a new one. Got going at 12.30 P.M. again. Bill finished S.E. 80 at 11.30 A.M. & I started right in on K 1/4 wheat. Folsom worked fairly well until 5 P.M. & then stopped with water in fuel. Took 1.14 C then & worked until 10.30 P.M. when binder gave out. Muriel & May out to town tonight & got repairs & will fix binder in morning. A beautiful evening.

Thurs Aug 5: Another lovely fairly warm day. Got binder fixed up by 9 A.M. & got in fair morning cutting with Folsom & quit K 1/4 wheat at noon & went down to C 1/4 wheat. Had very poor afternoon

there & finished up by getting 10-30 down there & did two rounds. Bill cut steadily all day finishing his at 3 P.M. (Gates shift) & then cut on C^o until 8 P.M. Meared & Mary up to Robinsons for afternoon & home at 8 P.M. Then they went out to town to get a couple of men to stock tomorrow and not home yet at 9:30 P.M.

Friday Aug 6: Still finished cutting wheat in about four hours steady cutting. Bill's binder were about out a boying at 9 A.M. so I went to town in car for one taking Mary with me and she went home on train. Got in fairly good day cutting all day. Few Ireland brothers stocked in east 80 all day. Shelt drove tree too this A.M. while George stocked this A.M. Wind east all day & air full of smoke. Mac and Lillian here this afternoon for visit & for supper.

Sat Aug 7: Finished what cutting at 11 A.M. but have a couple of sloughs to do after through the barley. Started in on barley in C^o but my binders gave trouble so came home at 11:30 A.M. & went to town. Home at 1:30 P.M. with no repair so Bill made one & we got going at 2:30 P.M. & got in good afternoon. Went to town tonight & took George, Bill, and Ireland brothers.

Sun Aug 8: A lovely morning & the four of us to church. Skewering this aft. but four of us down to the lake at 5 A.M. & stayed until 9:30 P.M. Had supper with Edwards, Tays, George Smith and Gte Milnes. Rained while we were at the lake and a very heavy shower through the night.

Mon Aug 9th: Heavy rain last night so could not cut today. Got a new man this morning - Steve Mann - so six men stocked up wheat this morning while I crushed & then seven of stocked this afternoon five in the C & wheat & Hall & I in the K place. The men finished the S.E. 80 at noon. A bright breezy day all day but wind from east. A very heavy rain at 7:30 P.M. and over an inch of rain fell in half an hour. Cleared off as we go to bed with wind from north.

Tues Aug 10: Wind n.w. and a lovely day. Hall & I stocked on K place this A.M. and then Bill George and I cut barley this afternoon. Steve, George, Bill, John, and Jim stocked up all the wheat this morning & then John & Jim stocked on K place this aft and finished here at 6:30 P.M. They then stocked in barley

east 80 where Steve had stocked all afternoon. It's Ind's birthday (44 years old). Ruth and Lyman had their toncils out to-day. A very good afternoon with binders and a lovely evening. Heard at noon that all crop two miles east of here was haled out last night.

Wed Aug 11: A dewy morning so boys did not get started cutting until 9 A.M. while Hall & I went down to Maricks with cow (Isabell). I took binder behind tractor while I got home while Steve just stood around for his board all day. Jim & John stocked barley all day and Hall fixed separator. He almost finished cutting barley tonight - about $\frac{3}{4}$ of an hour yet to do. Weather lightly tonight as we go to bed.

Thurs Aug 12: A warm bright day although very damp. Did A.M.

after last evenings shower. Got cutting at 10 A.M. & finished barley at 11 A.M. Bill then cut wheat in sloughs until 7.30 P.M. finishing he took one round in oats. He got started at oats with tractor & binder at 10.45 A.M. & cut steadily. Had one hour stop at 6 P.M. with packer work back led very steady day. In town bright & in
car to get crank & bundle carrier part welded. Walter worked at separator all day. Also worked in barley all S.M. but went to A Corporates at noon where he will work. Breland brothers stacked barley all day.

Friday Aug 15: Got cutting at 7 A.M. & had very steady day. Bill broke his big chain bat 6 P.M. but George & I cut until 8.30 P.M. & finished the oats. Men finished barley this A.M. & stacked in

oats all day. Walt to town tonight to get parts for binder, in car taking Bill Jim and John with him. Like rain tonight with south wind & lightning. Marion cut her oats today so Marid took car up there & Cecil took her to Dr. in town for stitches put in.

Sat Aug 16: A bright hot day with wind from south. Geo. & I took tractor & binder & started on barley on K.Y. & Bill followed with horse binder. Horse binder ground out grain - whole bearing set 11 A.M. so Bill took my binder behind tractor while I came home. Clarence brought out new bearing & bolting so Walt started on new shaft at 12.45 & stayed at it until 7 P.M. George & Bill brought tractor & binder home so horses will finish N barley. John & Jim stacked oats until 12 P.M. & then stacked barley this aft. I stacked for a time & then came home to help Marid

Barrie to unload road roller which he brought home. Muriel to town tonight to take out wash.

Sunday Aug 15: A lovely bright & fairly warm day. I did not go to church this morning but left for Kinney at 2.15 P.M. & got home at 12.30 A.M. Muriel ^{gathered} a mother to church this morning. Stewards down this aft will have for Moose Jaw in the morning. The Simmonds called this evening & will settle in McQuarrie house for the winter.

Mon Aug 16: Started threshing in S.E. 80 this morning got out about 800 bush. Also Smith got four loads this morning. Mr Hart brought hoppers at noon & took two loads (truck loads) to Mr. Delegers farm at Hinsdale. He brought in 3 loads to granary & unloaded two of them. A beautiful bright day

with wind from N.W. Muriel to town this aft in car & got Margaret Aitken who ~~wants~~ ^{I will} work here. Margaret Lep went home tonight. Dick Brandon & Stanley down from Cecil threshing all day.

Tues Aug 17: A very nice bright day again with wind from south and S.E. Threshed all day quite steadily putting out about 800 bushels. Walter & I drew home wheat to granary & ran machine alternately. ~~had~~ Finished up chores & unloading wheat at 9.30 P.M. Moon light tonight but lightning in the south.

Wed. Aug 18: A lovely day with strong wind from N.W. Threshed steadily all day. I went to Leavenay with load of grain with O. Emond while Gilbert Bourne took my place here. Back at 4.15 & put in load

afternoon trying to keep grain away.
Got chkd bin scraped full. Rev.
Elliott here for dinner & supper
& took Cecil to Brandon to have his
eye treated.

Tues Aug 20: Got in 2½ hrs.
threshing this morning when it started
to rain and did not do any more
all day. Mel, John & Jim threshed
oats this aft. Bill crushed this
aft while Walt & I attended to
correspondence. I. Knight sat in
light truck for pig and Mel Hart
but & got 100 bush. wheat & took it
to Hunsup. A. Cairns down to see
wheat tonight. Through chores fairly
early night (8 P.M.)

Wednesday Aug 20: Cloudy this morning
but a lovely bright afternoon with wind from
N.W. Bill & I stocked barley on K½ all morning
while Jim & John finished stocking oats & came to
barley at 11 A.M. Walt to town this morning &
took George out to stay until Monday. I helped
Bill get going on road mender with tractor on
K summerfallow & he will finish in another 1½ hrs.
tomorrow. Walt helped me Hart get separator
fixed up this aft & then Mel took last
load to Kenney. Jim & John stocked barley
with me all aft. Walt & I to Merricks
this evening on another feed trip with
grey cow. Home at 10 P.M. A lovely moon
light night.

Thurs Aug 21: A nice bright day
with wind from S.E. Walter left
early for Cecils with teams on binder
the A.M. but found it broken when
he got there so had to come home for
rebuild at noon but went up at

11: M. and has cut steadily all off at oats. Bill finished his summer fallow at 8 A.M. & sowed at 17 acres east of stable with seed weeder. Weeds pretty high so went at it with six horses on cultivator this off & finished tonight. Mariel went to town this A.M. in car taking John & left him there. Brought some cultivator till & crusher repair. I cleaned out granaries at K. place & crushed this off. Mariel to town in car tonight & took Margaret & Bill. Jim went to Milnes this A.M. and stocked all day. A lovely evening - full moon.

Sun Aug 22: A lovely day. All to church this morning. Mrs. Bestard here with Alex Lunn to look at seed wheat. Then Mr & Mrs. Harry Denzalff called & stayed until 8 P.M. Cepel Kennedy and family here this evening.

I wrote letter after 9 P.M. Walter up to Legs this evening to get Douglas Thompson who will thresh with us tomorrow.

Mon Aug 23: A fairly nice day with wind from east all day. Very tough threshing until 3 P.M. best got out 700 bushels. Hart took 100 bush to C. Kennedy 100 to Cecil & 100 bush to Art. Jackson Hopper & wagons full tonight. Stanley Cecil man went home at noon as he was not needed. A fairly good day all around.

Tues Aug 24: Dark and cloudy this morning and rained a little but did not stop us from threshing. North of here it rained much more and they could not thresh today. Geo. Smith did not start until noon. I ran stock team this A.M. but Stanley came at noon

so I gathered grain off old sets. They finished threshing on this farm at 7 P.M. & moved down to St. & but did not get set. A. Cairns got ~~two~~ two loads to sleep so got all his. Hart took load to Guy Williams this A.M. (50 bush). A lovely evening. Hart took 3 loads to Cecils this A.M. Mrs. B. M^o Clean here at noon to see wheat to-day at noon.

Ted Aug 25: A lovely hot day with fairly strong wind from the west. Got threshing at K place at 7 A.M. and almost finished at 7.30 P.M. mel Hart took 170 bush from here to Gardening (Bastards) and then took two loads of 130 bush each to Bastards & Luomas at Jaspers. Gordon here today from Aberdeen back & bought barley & oats from Walter. A lovely evening.

Thurs Aug 26: A lovely hot day bright and still. Finished threshing at my place at 8 A.M. and all men except Jim went up to Cecils but they did not get going until 3.30 P.M. making repairs on separator. Jim hitched up Cray & Dick & midgets on cultivator & did field C & D summer plan. I worked at tractor this A.M. but Marid came after me at 11.30 & we went to town to get repairs for machine. Jim went at least 80 after dinner. I got tractor home at 6 P.M. Miss Short here for supper. Mother & I up to Cecils to see the boys & get wrenches tonight.

Friday Aug 27: Very windy from the south. Bob Johnson going at 8 A.M. I went up to George Smicks & got rod weeder & rod weeded on C. Jim cultivated all morning & when we got home boys were here as couldnt thresh.

Leroy & John go this aft. Bill moved yard on & place this aft & fixed up nice. George, Jim, John & ~~Hector~~ Halle to town in car this aft. I rod weeded until 7.57 P.M.

Fri Aug 28: A beautiful day, fairly cool and calm. I got going with Gordon and rod weeded on C^{1/4} getting over half through. Quit at 6 P.M. Boys home from bushing at Ceele all day ^{and} at 8.45 P.M. and then took mother & ~~Hebe~~ ^{Muriel} and away to town. Bert Halle out with barrel of oil this morning.

Sun. Aug 29: A beautiful day. We 4 church but Halle. I slept after dinner & then Halle & I walked down to C^{1/4} summer yellow & then through bluff there & got a set full of hazel nuts. A beautiful fall day. Wrote letter tonight.

Mon Aug 30: A beautiful day. George took team up to Ceele after breakfast while Halle took Bill & Douglas Thomson up in car. I rod weeded with Gordon on C^{1/4} all day & finished tonight all I can do. Aunt Leggie Hebe & Nancy here for supper tonight. Through chores at 8.45 P.M. Dr. McConnell here to test cows to day & found all clear. A lovely day and evening.

Tues Aug 31: A cloudy morning but a bright afternoon and a lovely day. Started rod weeding in east 50 at 7.30 A.M. and got in a good day with Gordon. Mr. Lawson brought all of coal oil this morning. Mrs. H. Hompe here with two children this evening. A lovely evening. Halle intends coming here in car this evening & taking me to Montgomery to get Dr. Hollis & then I will take them to Ceele

and bring car down here for Marjel to see tomorrow.

Wed Sep 1: Another lovely day with wind from all directions. I got going with Tordson and rod weeding at 7:45 and had fairly good day in west 80. A lovely evening. Boys will finish threshing at 2 o'clock tomorrow morning so I won't bother riding tomorrow. Marjel went to town in car this morning & brought Margaret Aukten back with her.

Thurs Sep 2: A light rain through the night so did not get threshing until 7:45. I went up to Cools early in car & we finished there at 9:30 A.M. & got going threshing barley on K place at 11 A.M. Windy this aft but threshed steadily until day. I pitched in field with five bags.

Friday Sep 3: Uncle J. D. & Aunt Lizzie called this morning and stay and leaving for B.C. Saturday night. A lovely evening.

Sat Sep 3: Another lovely cool day, cloudy this A.M. but bright this aft. I worked in loft this morning and got it fairly full of straw. Pulled it to the field at 10:30 A.M. and threshed steadily all day. I pitched in field all day. I went to Greelyore at noon and helped Jacob treat a horse for encephalomyelitis. Through chores at 8:30 P.M. Almost finished on K place tonight - all straw on back.

Sun Sep 4: A cloudy morning & rained for an hour or so after we got moved over here at 9:30 A.M. So did not do threshing this A.M. (about 60 bush). Started at 1 P.M. & got out about 6:30 bush altogether this aft. Marjel took men into town tonight while Ialt & I did chores & threw off barley.

Sun Sep 5: A dull day all day. Muriel mother & I left to church this morning while I stayed home & had a sleep. Muriel & I to Kenney this aft & in to the aerodrome. Home at 1 A.M. Rainful considerable between 12 P.M. & 4 P.M. but clearing tonight.

Mon Sep 6: Bright & clear and warm today. I plowed garden with tractor this A.M. & did odd jobs this aft. Mel Hart & Vaneet bucked out four bushels today to go to McDonalds & Hartson. Walter crushed the morning and rod weeded this aft.

Tues Sep 7: I went to town taking Mother & Uncle Tom in car. Brought home radio from Patterson on trial. Uncle Tom to Brandon today. Brought Uncle Rob home with us tonight at noon & he extracted honey (about 55 lbs). I felt rod weeded in W 8s well

Pardon while Bill cultivated with horses & finished sunnalfallow at 8:30 P.M. I took George rod weeded home at 6 P.M. Mother, Muriel Maynard & I to town tonight in car to Rev. Mr. Elliott's induction. A lovely day & evening. Brought George Maynard & Ab. Hollis home tonight to treat

Wed Sep 8: A lovely day but tough threshing this A.M. - a dandy rain this aft. Set out over 1100 bush. barley. Put grain in granary bins A.M. but Hart trucked over 600 bush to town tonite the aft. Muriel left at 9 A.M. with Rev. Elliott & car load for Upp where she will stay until Saturday.

Thurs Sep 9: A splendid threshing day and we got along well. Finished barley at 10 A.M. and moved to west end of east 8s and bushed oats hauled from C 5s on C 4. Hart hauled out

two trucks of loads of barley and left a
little in the hopper. I threshed sixteen &
half loads of oats & put it in granary.
Hart Favel came out this morning
& pitched in $C\frac{1}{4}$ while we threshed oats.
A lovely evening & we quit at 7 P.M.

Tuesday Sep 10: Finished threshing all
now. Cecil took home Stanley and
two teams and we threshed oats (green)
all afternoon with four teams. Got
two stacks up and four loads in
two other butts. I took George Wilson
and Baba Favel to town tonight
while Gilbert Hollies went up to
Cecil's where he will stay a few days.
Halt paid off new sheo aft and cleaned
up macken and put it back on trees.

Sat Sep 11: I went to town this a.m.
& sold ~~sage~~ my barley. Walter & Bill
fence stacked all morning & then
Bill cultivated all aft on C $\frac{1}{4}$ while
Walter and I got in four loads of
sheaves but left three on racks.
Finished field & turned stock in
there. I took Bill & Margaret to
town tonight. Maril & Mr. Elliott
came home at 8 P.M. from Winnipeg.

Sun Sep 12: A lovely fall day
with just a hint of color now showing.
Mr. H. Dampf & Clenie went with Mother
Marie & I to church in car. Miss Short
here for lunch & Cecil & family here this
aft. Both away home at 8:30 P.M. A
lovely evening & to bed early.

Mon Sep 13: Another lovely dry day. Walter finished putting sheaves up in loft while I crushed this morning. Walter took tractor & separator up to Ceilo this aft & threshed raked up barley & some oats left from stacking. I took load down to K place & put in loft. Mr Sigartson & Bill Langster here this aft & Miss Robinson & Miss Short here for supper. A lovely evening. Walter home at 7 P.M.

night

Tues Sep 14: Walter married to town this morning where Walt went to dentist. I did odd jobs (got in sets & fixed up tractor) this A.M. & finished discing this aft in breaking on K place. Bill cultivated all day on summer fallow and K place. Rather cool to day. Walt started discing with 2 ft disc & 15-30 tractor at 3:30 P.M. Through chores fairly early to night.

Tues Sep 14: A very nice day except rather windy at noon. Walter started discing with tractor at 2:30 with Gordon while Bill cultivated also on K & summer fallow. Gordon and I & Bastard here this aft to settle for wheat. Mother & I to Kamloops this morning where mother visited Arnolds there & I went to Pollock. All of us into Brandon this aft to shop. We got home at 11:30 P.M. A lovely moonlight

Thurs Sep 16: A cold cool chilly morning but a beautiful afternoon. Walt got a fairly early start at discing with 15-30 tractor in southeast 80. I got late start on t. breaking with disc & Gordon & finished shortly after dinner. Tried cutting with mower on C after last but would not work. Bill finished cultivating on K place at 11 A.M. & cultivated east of barn rest of day. Mother

and Muriel up to Two Roads to Ladies
Missionary meeting to day this aft.

Friday - Sep 17: Cool this morning
but a lovely warm this afternoon. I
did odd jobs around while Hattie did
some stubble in S.E. 80. Then we both
dined here with tractor after dinner.
I got Carpenter's dice from Milnes at
noon. Had over 10 tenths (14 ft) & I
read over one 12 ft & got along well.
Bill cultivated East of stable this
A.M. in W. 80 he left. Mother and
Muriel up to Lanes (Blatons) to missionary
meeting this aft in our car.

Sat Sep 18: A very nice day. Hattie
and I got going on tractor & worked in S.E. 80
all morning & then Hattie finished it this
aft at 5 P.M. while I started on S.W. 80 on

K. place & got quite a little done. Bill
cultivated in W. 80 all day. Low denoted
here tonight for Sun Life Insurance Co.
too and stayed until 10.15 P.M. Bill
and Hattie away to town tonight.

Sun Sep 19: A beautiful day
with a touch of haze and the leaves
turning slightly golden and red. Early
day service at Oak Lake this morning.
Mother Muriel & Hattie out to the service
laking Charlie Campy & Glen and Baroy
Milne. All of us down to the river
this afternoon for a picnic - a lovely
time. Hattie & Muriel up to Celis tonight

Mon Sep 20: A beautiful day
I went with Mel Hart to Harding
Murray McKernons & Leo Dikes with
wheat for me. Hattie did 10-30
cultivated in W. 80
on C 1/4 all day & Bill up to Celis this
aft all day. Muriel up to Celis

after 4 P.M. and took Miss Short
with her. Both home at 9:30 P.M.
& Miss Short here for the night.

Saturday Sep 21: A cool day
but not cool - very nice day. I got two
trucks this A.M. driving on K. place
S.W. 55 with 10:30 while Walter went
to Skiatook. He dined in S.W. 55 on C.R.
with 10:30 this aft while I舞ed
Fordon on K place. Mel Hart out
& got 5 bushels of wild onions
this aft. Bill cultivated in W 80 all day.
Mother & Muriel visiting this aft at
Holden's.

Sunday Sep 22: Another very nice
day. I went to town in car & left at three
to be fixed & brought home a loaned car from
A. J. Stewart. Walter dined all day
on C.R. W.C. & finished tonight. I舞ed

in K.S.W. 55 this aft for a couple of hours
with Carlson. Bill cultivated in summerfield
W 80 all day. Miss H. Stumpf and family
here tonight & got tomatoes.

Tuesday: Cloudy all day and rained
most of the afternoon. Walt and I gathered
potatoes all day and got in sixteen bags.
Bill cultivated in summerfield all day.
(West 80). Ben and Horace Pollock
here this aft & for supper leaving at 8 P.M.
Dark & cloudy as we go to bed and
drizzling a little.

Wednesday Sep 24: A cold damp day
although no rain. We all picked potatoes this
A.M. & put in cellar & finished other work of
trees & in slough creek. Bill & I took out
potatoes S.W. of garden this aft while Walt
went to town to get car from Stories.

Geo Smith inv tonight to get car loaded ready for trip to Princeton tomorrow. Clear & cool tonight & like frost.

Sat Sep 26: A cool morning but nice afternoon. Bill & I picked potatoes in plot next to garden and finished putting them in pits at 6 P.M. Bill left at 8 A.M. for Moose Jaw in car taking Geo Smith with him. Very nice fall like day. Book of me at home tonight

Sun Sep 27: A beautiful day - partly warm and bright. To church this morning with Ruby and at her place for dinner. She brought us home at 4 P.M. Chores done early tonight & Bill out to church with Malone at Oak Lake.

Mon Sep 27: A lovely autumn day. Mr. Leo Gordon sale today but did not go. Bill & I dug my potatoes today & got them into the cellar at 6 P.M. Mother and Marib helped for a short time this afternoon. Cool & cloudy tonight.

Tues Sep 28: Cool and cloudy this morning. Bill cultivated in W 80 until he finished at 10 A.M. & then went into breaking on K place & finished there at 4 P.M. He then hitched onto disc & disc ed in N 30 on K 4 until 6 P.M. I took potato digger home after 4 P.M. & she helped Bill load up 120 bush (approx) of wheat for F. Hanson. Cail came down with belt so started cranks & cranked until 4 P.M. She went with tractor & Bill & got Hanson home from K place & then unloaded load of chpt.

Wednesday Sep 29: Cool and cloudy this morning & a very heavy frost but Bill got home at 8.30 A.M. and decided K & West of house until noon. I cleaned out pens & bailed calves & pigs & then Muriel and I set up stove in kitchen at my house. Gordon Todd drove in Brown's truck and got 44.8 bushel of wheat from our folks & 52 from. Started to rain & snow thin and kept up all afternoon. Bill & I did odd jobs until 6 P.M. Folks (Muriel & Mother) up to St David's with (K) uby to thank offering meeting.

Thursday Sep 30: Another cool and cloudy day but warmer this evening. Bill & I to Merricks with Rose this morning. Bill worked at murel boat this aft & attempted to take home

one Carpenter's disc but too much mud. It rained almost all night so was fairly ~~mud~~ ^{wet} today. I went to town at 12 P.M. in wagon & brought stove home at 4.45 & had it set up by 6 P.M. Also brought out 5 sacks of flour. No rain today but still cloudy tonight as we go to bed.

Friday Oct 1: A very cool and cloudy day all day and ground has dried very little. Bill worked at Stone boat all morning & then went discing on K place this aft. Could not double disc because of mud so came home & single disc'd in 8.30. I fixed up fence around stack in yard - worked at boat & engine back aft and did other odd jobs.

Sat Oct 2: A dull dark cloudy day and a little moisture fell at times. Bill sliced all day in east 80 (single). I cleaned out stables this A.M. & then cleaned out coal shed. I went down to C.H. & turned up straw pile to burn. Muriel out to town with Ruby & Annie Milne to hoary-looking sale. Walter and George home from Moose Jaw tonight at 4:30 P.M. Bill & I into town in car this evening.

Sun Oct 3: Another wet day dark & cloudy. We all went to church in car this morning & then I to Murray this afternoon in car & home at 1:30 P.M. To D's & Habs for supper. Roads muddy but quite passable

Mon Oct 4: Cloudy all day and raining all afternoon. Walter & I put up the stove pipes at K place & put in four bags of flour. Then we got in carrots. George Merrick here at 11 A.M. & got our cultivator. Walter fixed disc tiller aft. while I scrubbed kitchen at K place. Muriel took Bill Adolph as far to Brandon in car this aft. soiled by wild as to Steinbach having passed her. Marion Cecil & Stanley the man accompanied her. Home to Cecil at 4:30 but not home tonight

Tues Oct 5: Rained all night and most of the day but cleared at 9 P.M. Cecil brought Muriel home in buggy at 11:30 P.M. I took down beds & cleaned up at Lynn Louise till 2 A.M. Muriel & I down to K house & ^{painting} set up st pipes & floors & started fire in stove.

I took posts down to pasture before dinner. Halt crushed them a bit while I recovered potatoes in pits with straw. None frozen so far although heavy frost this morning. I went down to marricks tonight to tell George about taking pies to Knights tomorrow. Packed trunk for a time tonight.

Thurs Oct 7: Another heavy frost last night. I got two loads of wood from George Street & took them down to R. place today. Halt dug up vegetables in garden & loaded up Mieke Wete with 108 bush. of

hatched wheat. Cecil down & got load of grain crushed to-day this aft & Halt home with him and brought home -ers. Cloudy again this evening. I brought in garden vegetables in wagon after coming home from Georges this aft.

Friday Oct 8: A nice bright day but rained a fairly heavy shower at 3:30 P.M. We washed the car and polished the st. Halt washed our clothes this morning & fixed tire this afternoon. Mr. Elliott and Mr. Banister here for dinner collecting for car to send to Fred. Part out of place with three tons of coal this aft. I left at 8 P.M. for Kenney to a party at G. Drivings. Stayed all night at Oshocks. A very nice shower for Beatrice.

Sat Oct 4: A cloudy day again & got home at 11 A.M. & fixed up mowers. Uncle J. G. out to Ochre's Ds. A.M. so called for Mother on way back and took her into town. Father did chores and odd jobs this morning and then went he disc'd in Elba this aft. I took the Am. Carpenters disc home to him this aft & then attempted to mow but broke mower. Met Hart out with 3 1/2 tons of coal for the home place. Hart & I in to town tonight & had brought Mother home with us.

Sun Oct 5: A lovely day. All of us to church this morning to hear Mr. Caldwell Ina home with us at noon & then Cecil all down at 5 P.M. & here for supper. and went home at 8 P.M. Wrote account & read this evening

Mon Oct 6: A cold somewhat windy day with wind from north. After doing chores I went to town in car to get a man for when we go away for the week but could not get one so came home at 12:30 P.M. Father disc'd all day in Elba. I did odd jobs this afternoon getting ready for tomorrow. Mr. H. Gompf & son Charlie over for the evening to learn about doing chores. I bid early tonight. Cool & cloudy but freezing as we go to bed.

Tues Oct 7: Our wedding day and rather cool & cloudy although sun shone at 1:30 P.M. Wedding at 12 P.M. reception at the house & then Bea & I away to Winnipeg for a trip. Home to Kenway on Sat Oct 10. Bea & I to Fairplay to visit Rosella Sunday Oct 11 A lovely afternoon.

Mon Oct 12: Cool & cloudy all day. Art Carpenter down to Gollock's with J. Goodwin's truck & brought home

our effects; Walter came down in car
and brought Bea home. Art & I unloaded
truck here at N. place & then Art into
town for dinner. Got Bea & I up home for
dinner & then back to settle things. Home
again for supper & the night. A quiet

evening.

Tues Oct 19: Another cool cloudy day
Bea & I worked away here all day while Walt
discussed on this place. Reception at home
tonight for us. About 30 present & a lovely
time. We slept up home tonight. Got
many more gifts. Art & Jack Goodwin put out new
furniture at 6 P.M.

Wed Oct 20: Cool & cloudy most of
day again. Got all of the furniture in
and the congoium rug this aft. & everything
set. I went up to do chores at 5 P.M.
Cold tonight.

Thurs Oct 21: A nice day and did
some more fixing up around home. Raked
house while Bea burned at lawn. Lee

all day.

got a radio set out this afternoon. We
did some fixing up this A.M. Walt
got some sleep around at home this A.M.
and then discussed on this place this aft
finishing W 38 acres. At 3:45 P.M. Muriel
Bea & I out to town in car tonight
& did some shopping. Home at 10:45 P.M.
A warmer lovely evening.

Sat Oct 23: A lovely warmer
day bright & calm. After doing chores

into cellar but didn't finish. Walter

Tues Oct 24: A beautiful bright warm day - a real Indian summer day. Bea Mother Muriel & I went to church in Oak Lake in the car to their Anniversary services (Mr. Rev Burdell from Harbor mind his A.M.). Walter here after dinner while Bea & I stayed there for noon meal. Ina Lynn & Ruth down visiting this aft. while Cil & Marian visited up there. Walter Muriel Marian & children out to town to church this evening. Bea & I up here after supper. I did dishes while I did chores outside. She both came home at 9 P.M. A lovely warm evening.

Mon Oct 25: Another very nice day I went up home & got in best opportunity into cellar with wagon, bagging 5 bags ready for town for Mrs. Kennedy. Walter raked up Russian Shingle in S.E. 8 this A.M. & did odd job this aft. I went to the funeral of Mr. Alex McDonald this aft. in car taking Ceeby, George and Cecil. All of us away at 6 P.M. to the Jacob Supper and Entertainment at Oak Lake. Home at 11 P.M.

Tues Oct 26: A cool & bright day with wind from west. I went home & got 6 horses & disced on the 1/4 (NE. 47) all day getting about 10 acre done. Ialt raked this morning & bailed before dinner & then Bea & Russian Shingle this aft. Bea up visiting some folks this aft. A lovely evening.

Wed Oct 27: A bright sunny day. I got dicing at 8 A.M. but quit at 11 A.M. and got away to Stokes saw at 1 P.M. A lovely afternoon. I bought a cow and Art Carpenter and Jack Goodwin brought her out in the truck tonight. Marcell and Bea out to town with me this aft. Walter raked Russian kitch in S.E. 40th and went to town to Methodist meeting tonight.

Thurs Oct 28: A bright clear day warm with a slight haze. I spent most of day in N.E. 40th finishing at 4 P.M. Walter did odd jobs around yard today this A.M. and went to Brandon in car this afternoon to U.F.M. convention. Beatrice went with him as far as Summey. I did chores at home and had supper there before coming home to do milking here.

Fri Oct 29: A bright day but windy this afternoon from N.W. I made a shelf in pantry this morning & did odd jobs. While Walter raked up Russian kitch in S.E. 80th. He raked & I burned this aft. Mother & Marcell out visiting this aft & Ruby over. Clara Carpenter in here for a few minutes this evening. A lovely evening but a silly wind from N.W.

Sat Oct 30: A lovely day - very calm and bright. I scythed yard here this morning after doing chores at home and then burned Russian kitch this afternoon. Walter raked all day in S.E. 80th. Beatrice up to Mother's for afternoon & Miss Short over to visit. Sett down here this evening to hear radio. A lovely evening.

Sun Oct 31: A beautiful day with wind from N.W. Bea and I to church with home folks and then alone until 3 P.M. visitors Doris & Bill Pollock called in on way from Brandon. At 5:30 Marjory & Bill & Miss Buckley called from Hartney & Stas stayed for the evening. Supper at home & lunch here at 11 P.M. and then everyone left. A lovely evening

Mon Nov 1: A cold cloudy day all day with snow & rain falling this morning. Mrs. Kennedy here this morning & he & I down to Clarence to see horses. I fanned all afternoon in 6 acres north of barns & got 3 way down east side. Bea baked & churned today. Ialt raked Russian Thistle this A.M. and put on storm windows & doors this aft.

Tues Nov 2: A bright day but fairly cool - about 4° above zero this A.M. I got fanning at 9 A.M. & did about $\frac{2}{3}$ of east side of 6 acres north of barn. Walter put manure along south side of cow stable. Muriel Bea & I to town this aft in car & home at 4:30. Mrs. B. Dampf, Miss Short & Beulah Dampf all here for the evening.

Wed Nov 3: A warmer day. Ialt & I backed in machinery up home & then started to crush. I brought a load doves here & then ran Gordon tractor down here & put it in the shed. Cecil & Ruth brought down load of grain & got it crushed & then Ialt did one for up home. Mrs. Cochran, Jessie McElie, Mrs. Higginbotham, Mrs. Bannister, and

Nov 5 Mrs Dorschick out in car to mothers this afternoon. Bea up & Marian down. Both of us up home for supper tonight & home here to do chores.

Tuesday Nov 5: A cool day cloudy at times. I went to George Smith's at 9:30 A.M. and sawed all day. Beatrice came at 11:30 A.M. and stayed there all day. George brought us home in the car at 8:30 P.M. Cool & cloudy tonight as we go to bed.

Wednesday Nov 6: A rather nice bright day and a lovely afternoon. I went up home and did chores early this morning while Walter went to George Smith's and sawed wood all day coming home at 5:30

P.M. Maril down this morning and helped Bea prepare for a tea this aft. Mrs. Annie Middle C. Corp. Mrs. Karm Helton Herring, Rocky Smith & our own folks all down this aft. I burned slough this aft.

Sun Nov 7: A very nice day
bright this A.M. but dull & cloudy
this afternoon and raining lightly
at 8 P.M. & stopping at 10 A.M.
We all went to church this morning
in the car. Did chores early &
Mother muriel and Walter over in
car for supper.

Mon Nov. 8: A little damp
all day from last night. Foggy
this morning. I fenced all day (plenty
posts this morning & laid ~~the~~ were
this aft. Mr. Miller, Mr. Elliott,
Ruby's Aunt Lizzie all out at 2 P.M.
to visit. A warm day but no rain.
Walt took Cecil & G. Dinnmor to
Grosvenor at 1 P.M. to catch train

bridge.

Tues Nov 9: Dear birthday anniversary
I fenced all day while Walt crushed
at home for Hurlberts south of Oak
Lake. Mr. Kennedy & Amo Carpenter
out to see me at fence this morning
and Camille Franklin out this afternoon
Mrs. Kennedy in to see Bea this morning
Bea Muriel & Mother to town in car
this aft. Walter up to St. Louis with
Geo Smith to nomination. A
wonderful day warm and bright, very
sunshiny like.

Wed. Nov 10: A fairly nice day
but a little cooler and dull most of day.
I fenced all morning and then went
down to Amo Carpenter's & clapped 30
Oak posts. Home at 6.30 P.M. Walter
raked in C.H. all morning & burned
Russian thistle. I will & Walter out to
town tonight to Rebecca entertainment.
Wind S.E. all day.

Thurs. Nov 11: A beautiful calm sunshiny like day - armistice day. I sawed off post ends from oak posts I got yesterday from A. Carpenter, this morning. Then I went to town in wagon this aft and got steel trough and 2100 lbs of coal. Home at 6 P.M. & then got chores done and Bea left Marcell & I went in car to Buckleys at Hartney to barn dance. Home at 3 A.M. I felt burned Russian kettle all day. Mother & Marcell out to town in car to Armistice service - to Uncle Tom's (J.S.) for dinner.

Friday Nov 12: A cold cloudy day. I unloaded coal this morning and then got team this aft. and put out posts. Took team home then & planted posts until at 3 P.M. until 5:45 P.M. Bea went to town with Annie Milne Marcell & Mother in Annie's car & then on to

Marians to a missionary meeting home at 5:45. To bed very early tonight looks & feels like snow.

Sat Nov 13: A heavy snow storm last night & about 6 inches of snow lying in yard. Snowed most of day lightly. I did odd jobs & went up home as well as fixed up storm windows. Went to town with Clarence Kennedy in truck & brought home cream separator. A fairly nice night.

Sun Nov 14: A dull cloudy day. Married Bea & I up to church in buggy (Polly) leaving here at 11 A.M. Went to Cecils for dinner, Marcell will stay until tomorrow. Bea and I home at 6 P.M. Snow 8 inches deep in places. Mrs. Elliott finished No Sunday School.

Mon Nov 15: A bright sunny day with cold wind from N. E. Clarence and I down to bridge at 10.30 A.M. and brought Charlie Smith's 14 horses home to Clarence & also brought 3 mares one sucking colt and the saddle pony here to keep all winter. Bea & I up home at 5 P.M. & have few supplies. Lyman brought mare home at 5.15 P.M. Walter got in straw and sweet clover this afternoon. A beautiful moonlight evening with moon shining on white sparkling snow.

Tues Nov 16: A cold day but bright. I got Mac & Bob & stone boat this morning, cleaned out stable before dinner. Bea up home ~~at~~ this A.M. & did her washing. Hall & I killed a pig up here this aft. A lovely evening

Wed Nov 17: A cold day with north wind cloudy this A.M. but bright this aft. I cleaned out stable this A.M. & then brought down pig ½ of pig carcass. Cut it up after dinner & then finished planting fence posts. Roll up home on pony tonight. Home tonight - a lovely evening

Thurs Nov 18: Another cold day. I cleaned out stable this A.M. and went to town this aft & then on to Herberts & Mrs. Stackhouse then home at 6 P.M. on horseback (Pat.). A lovely evening but cloudy.

Friay Nov 19: A cold day but bright and clear. Cleaned out stable this morning and took it ~~up~~ ^{out} this aft & got load of bedding then went fencing & rolled out a

length of wire - back of stable. Bea
and I walked up home tonight
& got Folly in buggy & went to
A. Carpenter's for the evening.
Halter rode up to Ryerson to
community club meeting on Sat
tonight. Halter down this A.M. & helped
ring pigs.

Sat Nov 20: A little milder
to-day. Fixed window in bathroom
this A.M. & worked at pulling down bin
in granary. Cold tonight. Muriel to
town this aft in buggy.

Fri Nov 21: Cloudy most
of day. Hal & Muriel to church in buggy
this morning. Bea & I raked most of
afternoon. Hal & Muriel down at 8:30
P.M. for the evening. To bed at 11:15 P.M.

Mon Nov 22: A little warmer to day.
Halt chores all done this morning & then
Halter came up at 2 P.M. & we worked
at fixing up wall in stable all aft.
& he went home at 5 P.M. A lovely evening
and not too cold.

Tues Nov 23: Warmer this A.M.
and got warmer as day went on
until quite soft & warm tonight. Hand

Thurs Nov 25: A dull cloudy and warm day. I did chores and then fixed up at barn. Mr & Mrs Pollock Florence and Margaret Rose came at 2 P.M. in car & stayed for the afternoon leaving 1.20 P.M. Bear & I went up home & got the car & went to Lompof for the evening. A very nice time & home at 12.30 A.M. Walter crushed this afternoon.

Friday Nov 26: A colder day with occasional snow flurries & sleet storms. I went home this aft & crushed all aft. Then Doherty down to get a load crushed.

Walter got load of straw this aft. Bear not feeling well this evening. Colder tonight.

Sat Nov 27: A cold day with strong wind from N.W. After cleaning out stable this morning I went up home with team & got the load of chaff I crushed yesterday. Unloaded it this aft and worked at piping up wall in loose stable. Took home wagon this evening & got mail which Malt & Muriel got when they went in in car this aft.

Sun Nov 28: A very cold day but not so windy. Did not go to church today. 25° below this morning. Bear & I up home after supper tonight and home at 11 P.M.

Tues Nov 29.: I never lay by & still very cold. I did chores this A.M. and then went up home & got -sleigh & boy. Then went to town at 1.30 P.M. Home down at noon I brought home lumber for stable. Bea up home this aft. leaving & me presents. A lovely walking & snowing a little as we go to bed.

Tues Nov 30.: A lovely day. Snowed lightly this A.M. but bright this aft. Cleaned up stable & hen house this A.M. & tall cane down this aft & we almost completed wall in stable. Wilbur Smith and his wife over home for supper from Weston. Wilbur down here at 7.30 P.M. & we accompanied him up home where Uncle Rob, Aunt Linda, & Jessie were visiting. Home at 12 A.M. & Wilbur & wife leaving for Saugus this week.

Wed Dec 1.: A very nice day After doing chores went up home with sheep tongue & spent afternoon fixing it up for manure boat. Bea baked this morning & went up home and worked this afternoon.

Thurs Dec. 2.: A mild fair day but cloudy this aft. Did chores this A.M. and worked at stable wall almost finishing. Then worked at fence north of stable tonight this aft almost finishing tonight. Horse sick tonight but apparently better as we go to bed. Bea to a mission meeting this aft with Ruby but baked this A.M.

Friday Dec 3.: A cold day but not bad. Wind from N.W. & colder tonight with an occasional snow

flurry. Did chores this A.M. - fixed at
her house this aft. Uncle T.J. Aunt
Lizzie & Douglas out here this aft and
Stayed an hour or so. Walter Muriel
Bea & I up to Ryerson school tonight
to Community club and dance. Home at
3 A.M.

Sat Dec 4: A very cold day with
wind from N.W. and rather blustery.
Got chores done early and then took
Pat up home and fitted him with
Polly's tank. Muriel to town in sleigh
calling at Bannister's place to see a
couple of cows. Muriel went to show.
Home at 2:00 to 7 P.M. A cold but
calm evening.

Sun Dec 5: A very nice day and

Fri Dec 8: A cold blustery day
with strong wind from N.W. I went up house
this A.M. and got parcel Leo Miles brought
out last night. I find at barn this aft
but didn't finish. Halter down here this
evening at 8.30 P.M. Cold tonight.

Sat Dec 9: Another cold day but
not so stormy. Did chores this A.M. & went up
house this aft to do some carpenter work but
lumber no good. To Hall & I put sack
from truck over to slough. Cold again
tonight but moonlight.

Sunday Dec 10: A fairly nice
day. I got chores done this morning.

A lovely evening bright & moonlight. Gray Beelbust brought

Thurs Dec 16: Another mild day but cloudy. Did chores this morning & got in some bushy share for horses. Cut up rest of beef after dinner & then went up home to creek for rest of afternoon. Home at 5.15 P.M. Bea over to school to practice for entertainment tonight. Lovely evening.

Friday Dec 17: A mild calm day
Cloudy at times. Bed chores by 8.30 A.M.
then fixed up stable & kept Bea with
churning. Help home after dinner and cut
up meat & helped Walter with straw. Home
at 5 P.M. for the evening.

Sat Dec 18: Snowed lightly all
day. I did chores & went up home at 1 P.M.
got rock load of sweet clover hay here by
12 P.M. After dinner unloaded hay
and got load of barley straw and
piled it behind barn. Then Bea
washed clothes at mother's this morning.
Snowing as we go to bed this P.M.

Sun Dec 19: Laid around all
day and read. Went over house after
6 P.M. and did Walter's milking while

Tues Dec 21: A warm A.M. but
wind from N.W. & grew colder all
day until pretty cold tonight. Did

We decorated house for Xmas tonight.
Pretty cold tonight.

Wed Dec 22: Cold but fair today
I did chores this morning & went up home

Sat Dec 27: A cold day but got chores done this morning & cleaned out her house this aft. Then went up home and helped Walter unload a load of straw. Asked to

Grubbs for supper so got chores done early & got there by 2 P.M. A lovely evening & supper home at 12 M. Bea phoned home at 9 P.M. that she is coming home tomorrow & bringing ~~Mary~~ with her.

George Milne & family and Geo. Smith's family with Marcell. Walter came at 8.15 P.M. and stayed for the evening. A lovely time.

Wed Jan 15: A warm morning but cooler this aft. I got sleigh from home this aft. with 4 blocks of ice. Then Bea & I went over to Geo. Smith's in sleigh & got load of wood. Snowing lightly at 6 P.M. & at it as we go to bed. Bea & I at home tonight listening to radio programs.

Sun Jan 16: A cloudy day and snowing lightly almost all day. Bea & I over home for afternoon. Then Muriel back with us for supper & they all of us over home again for the evening. Bea & I home again at 11 P.M.

McRicks to tell him to sterilize his horses preparatory to treating for bots. Home at 10. 35 & cat stable cleaned out before dinner. & laying over snow since 10 and returning to bed for tomorrow. Went to town & to sleigh this aft. & home at 11:30 P.M. Clear tonight but cold.

Wed Jan 19: A beautiful bright day and moderately cold. See Ricks here this A.M. & treated horses for worms. I did chores this aft while Bea and Muriel walked over to Rubys for the afternoon. A lovely evening and not too cold. Walter home today and got a load of straw this aft. He put about 30 bushels of water in ice well today.

Thurs Jan 20: A foggy nice day with trees covered with snow. I did chores & got a small load of sweet clover from home this P.M. Shalt a load of straw for yard this aft. Went out to town in cutter this aft to a pool meeting. A lovely evening.

Friday Jan 21: A lovely bright day,西北 wind from S.W. Did chores this A.M. then went home with stone boat & got bag of barley. Put water in ice well this aft & then did chores early. Sun Jan 23: A lovely day Bea & I went over home at 3 P.M. & visited Shalt for a couple of hours then home for chores & supper. Muriel & mother up to Celis in cutter for noon dinner & home at 5.30 P.M. Bob Montgomery over to visit this aft & then back to H. Gompp's for supper. Wind turned north tonight

Mon Jan 24: Much colder today & below zero with cold north wind. Did chores this morning & then up home this aft to help set up cutter but did not finish. Home here at 5:25 P.M. Very cold tonight. Bea cleaned this aft.

Tues Jan 25: A little cold day so left cleaning out stable until after dinner. Home this P.M. and again at 5:30 P.M. Bea canning meat & baking bread to-day. I put 20 pails of water in ice well this aft. Northern lights tonight and very cold.

Wed Jan 26: I went over home early this morning & took Muriel to town to catch 10:30 train. A cold morning but warmer than yesterday. Did chores this afternoon, and

all through at 3 P.M. Used new cutter for first time today.

Tues Feb 8: A dull day and 14° below & then began to snow at 2 P.M. and still at it as we

got to bed. Did chores this A.M. yet team ready left home with load of oats at 15° F. M. Home at 5.30 P.M. in snow storm.

Wed Feb 9: A very nice day, 15° above zero. Did chores this morning & went up some distance with letter to Mr. S. Got out good around this afternoon. Remained (Ben, George & Miss Felt) at home tonight and Peter & I made it over to town. Dined at 7.30 P.M. for supper. Mr Gray (new Carpenter) was out home.

Thur Feb 10: A stormy day and east wind from E. and much snow falling. Did not clean out stable but left snow in walking by fire. The cattle just kept so to best eating.

Feb. 1^{Tuesday}: A bright day but cold and blowing cold from N.W. Wind since headache this m. Also cleaned out stable this aft. Up home after dinner & got some aspirins & other medicines. So had ~~to~~ early tonight. Met Marcel up to Kipperton last night to Red Cross concert.

Feb. 2^{Wednesday}: A strong day most of day. Got stable cleaned out till A.M. Went up to Gillies afternoon before he left for town accompanied by Mr. Goad. It rained fairly hard all afternoon and at night strongly as we go to bed. Wind from east.

Feb. 3^{Thursday}: Snowed until daylight and left banks 2-3 feet deep. Hard getting around. I went up to Mothais & got parcels from town. A bright day but drifting all day.

Mon Feb. 4^{Friday}: Cloudy this AM but bright this aft. At Hanmer this afternoon this aft (2 loads) snow as deep can hardly get through. Bee & Dufu have on stone boat. We aft & home at 7 P.M. A very nice night right.

Tues Feb 15: A very cold day 32° below zero. Halted over this AM at 8 this again at 12 P.M. with such. We loaded pigs 30 swine & 2000 skinned out 5 miles. Harvey racing. Home at 3.5 P.M. (Pigs weighed 3.742) Marcel over this aft.

Wed Feb 16: Fairly cold all day but dull & snowing a little. Found at gasoline camp this aft and did odd chores. Halted down tonight & cut lawn.

Thurs Feb 18: A nice day but fairly cold tonight. I got up & home & got rock at moon & went down & got a sack of sweet clover. I also got load of straw & put it in yard for horses. Home at 6 P.M.

Fri. Feb 19: I got up home. Mrs. J. H. is carrying case to day to St. David's to night so did not go to stable. Cleaned out & went until the off Walter to town. He left main road of auto. & home at 6.45 P.M. Mrs. J. H. & Mariel I went to F. & Son's drug & cosmetic store in Foster Avenue. I stayed with Mariel & Bea 1 hour all 130. Opened new regals. A very salut evening. Home by 9 o'clock.

Fri. Feb 19: A little milder to-day. Cleaned out stables this A.M. and then went up home this aft & crushed with Ruth ~~the~~ aft. Home at 5.30 P.M. Got quite a little cracked. Sun & cloudy most of the day.

Sun Feb 20: Quite a little warmer to-day. Stayed home until 6 P.M. Then went over to Mother's for supper. Mariel still away at Greens and Godwin.

Mon. Feb 21: A little milder. Cleaned out stable & then went to see Walter at 1 P.M. Bea & I had dinner for my mother & myself at 2 P.M. Home at 5 P.M. A very nice day & mild.

Tues Feb 22: A mild day & bright this aft. Cleaned out stables this A.M. and up home on stone boat this aft for bag of barley. Made out books this aft. To bed early.

Wed Feb 23: A nice mild day did chores this morning and went up home & got back load of sweet clover. Brought it home & got a load of straw to spread in yard. Sea washed and cleared to-day.

Thurs Feb 24: Another mild day. Walter to town this aft. in center day. Up home this morning & at noon did odd jobs this aft.

Friday Feb 25: A warm day and melted considerably this aft. I carried pails of water into ice well. Did chores early & then over to Walter's and up to Ryerson with him to entertainment & dance. Brought Dorine home with us, who has been up at St. David's for the week.

Sat Feb 26: A very warm day & clouds went away very considerably. Did chores this A.M. & got a load of crop from home this aft and then took home slugs. To bed early tonight. A good deal of water poured off roof to-day.

Sun Feb 27: Another warm day but dull. Jerry cow had male calf this A.M. Bear married to Melvin this morning for mail & then the two of us up home this aft until 5 P.M. Misty tonight

Tues Feb 28: Another warm day and snow went away very much. Got chores done this A.M. Helped up home after dinner & brought back soldering outfit. Fixed at trough & then carried out ashes to burn from cellar. A lovely evening. Southwest wind.

Wed Mar 1: A lovely warm day with pools of water around building. Walt came down with load of manure at 10.15 A.M. as he could not spread it (rose back). So I put my load over it & spread in my field N.E. of stable. Then took his up home & watered cattle. Bea up there washing so lots of us stayed for dinner. When we got back found twin black calves (heifers) I split wood this aft. It snow tonight & found it a lot much better.

Thurs Mar 2: Got chores done this A.M. and to town this aft taking Uncle J.S. along in cutter. Bea up home for the afternoon. Walter selling his back most of aft. Spent dollars here for the evening to make plans for me to go to E. Deyo's with P. Deyo to eat tomorrow. Cost twenty.

Fri Mar 3: Did chores this A.M. & was home & helped out to E. Deyo with 38 bushels of wheat. It changed zero to day with sound from P.E. and pretty cool.

Sat Mar 3: Did chores this A.M. & then Bea & I up to Mother's with team. Bea mother and Mabel then on to E. Deyo's to Day of Prayer. I helped clean up afternoon, then began to do chores. Walter home here with us for

supper. Then all of us up to Drayys
for the evening. Home at 2.30 A.M.

Sat Mar 5: A fairish wind day
Walter away to Mrs. F. Taylor's funeral
with Leo Dillie & some with Leo
Milne. I went up home & got out
(3 lbs.) of oat straw & didn't get
load of straw for yard here. Though
closed at 8 P.M.

Sun Mar 6: A very nice day
but fairly cold. Got chores done early.
Bec over home at 10:30 A.M. and then
Marie closed before 11:30 to all as
that Marie Mother & Walter would be
down for supper. They came at 6:30 P.M.
A lovely evening.

Mon Mar 7: A calm day & didn't
do nothing at little in the slate.
I did chores this A.M. & then up home
& got Cee & Walter to come down &
try to pull out pump. Couldn't however
so went up home & helped Walter do
some odd jobs. Ran up home with
the last of Cee's marl & with
away home at 6:15 P.M. Cee & I walked
& did chores after our return here.

Tue Mar 8: A roasting afternoon.
Walter & I each took a walk & turned
down to reserve for wood but none
here so returned empty. A very
nice day. Took dinner down to
Clarance to be fixed this aft.

Mon Mar 14: Cloudy all day but snow melted now to lay snow for some time. Did chores this morning and away for wood at 1 P.M. Halters went also. Home at 3:30 P.M. Listened to Rev. Mr. Barker speaking at noon, on German Crisis. Still warm tonight. Saw first cow at noon today.

Tues Mar 15: A very warm day Halters took cattle toward the noon & snow melt now at wood lot at 3:30 P.M. & we each brought load of wood. He only got us as far as Harrison where he broke his coneflakes. Came rest of way with horses on one load. Still very bad & much road bare. Chores done very late tonight.

Wed Mar 16: Halt took the milch cows this A.M. and then on to Bdn fair. Elmer stopped doing chores for Halters & he & I went down & got other load of wood at Harrison at 11 A.M. Home at 3 P.M. Did my chores after arriving home & having dinner. Snow disappeared a great deal today.

Thurs Mar 17: Did chores this A.M. and made trip home. Muriel down at 10:30 and helped Bea cut meat. Halters & I down to Bannister's wood lot this aft but didn't get much cracked out because it took billions attack. Halters rushing down hills and threw culverts and melting pretty fast. Finished chores at 2:30 A.M.

Friday Mar. 8: Another warm day
Did not clean out stable ^{out} & stall &
took cord wood rack ^{& high} at 11 A.M.
Took our dinner & drew down wood
out of beast & piled it at foot of hill.
Melted much more today. Flew kites
at 9 P.M.

Saturday Mar. 9: Another warm day
and Walter took Farley Vilas oil
cord wood such board to base & hauled
out rest of wood & piled at there. Snow
almost all disappeared to-day leaving
fields bare looking except for large
sloughs. I tried to get fuel out of
well this aft but failed so spent rest
of afternoon splitting wood. Then
chores at 8 P.M. & to bed early.

Sun Mar 10: Warm again &
very little frost last night. Bea & I
walked up some ~~the~~ ^{old} but otherwise
spent very quiet day.

Mon Mar 11: A cloudy rainy &
snowy day. I went up home at 1:30 P.M.
^{wagon} & I got a load of chop over
to stable and then I brought load down
here & unloaded it. Took team & wagon

to go to town to-morrow.

Tues Mar 12: A nice day & melted
a lot again. Walter went to town

on to dredges & got cucumbers & sage.

Wed Mar 23: A lovely warm day but cold and frosty this morning! Got chores done at 9.30 A.M. (didn't clean out stable) and away on horse back to Oak Lake to see dentist. Home at 3.30 P.M. Bea up home while I was away. Walter down tonight for hair cut. Playing a little tonight.

Thurs Mar 24: Another nice warm day although frosty this afternoon. Did chores this A.M. & went up home at 1.30 P.M. Got a load of straw put some in loft & bedded sows with rest. Set up saw ready to saw tomorrow and then took cows to Milnes. Home here at 6.30 P.M. Culen & Lompy visited Bea after 4 P.M.

Friday Mar 25: Did chores early this morning and then up home at 9.45 A.M. & sawed wood at home finishing their $2\frac{3}{4}$ cords at 1 P.M.

Then down here at 1 P.M. and finished at 1.30 P.M. ($1\frac{3}{4}$ cords) and then over to Geo Milnes & finished his four cords at 4 P.M. Geo Milnes tractor doing all the sawing. Bea, Maril & I up to Ryerson school tonight to Boy social. Home at 4 P.M.

Sat Mar 26: Another warm day. Cleaned out stables, tried to start tractor & did other odd jobs and split wood. To bed early tonight.

Sun Mar 27: A lovely day and warm drying up well. Maril came down with him & Bea & she & I went to church. A good crowd out. Home at 1.30 P.M. Maril here for lunch & then Bea & I up home for supper. A lovely day.

Mon Mar. 28: A dull day at times but 70° above zero, and dried a great deal during the day but raining after supper to night and at 10 we go to bed. Up at 6 A.M. & split wood after doing chores this A.M. & then up home at 1 P.M. with teams. Cleaned grain all aft. & then brought home load of ashes after 6 P.M. and unloaded them.

Tues Mar 29: Rained fairly heavily all last night and most of today. Did chores this A.M. and up home by 10 A.M. Tied a tie this A.M. Then up again at 12 P.M. & cleaned grain all afternoon doing 37 bush. Rained too to sew aprons & quilt. Stayed for supper and home at 7:30. A little colder tonight and rain turning to snow.

Wed Mar 30: Left at 9 A.M. with Geo. Milne in car for N. Aitken sale. Home at 7 P.M. Cold & snowing lightly all day. Rained up home this morning washing, stayed for dinner. Baby also there. Waited with us to sell. Snowing lightly as we go to bed.

Thur. Mar 31: 26° above this morning. did chores this A.M. and up home cleaning house at 1 P.M. afternoon got 54 bush done. Snowed & cold all day. Freezing hard tonight.

Fri April 1st: Up & farmed chores this morning myrie, down to town. Went to town this afternoon with teams & wagon. Hay were needed. Freezing tonight. Drawled some this afternoon. Home at 6 P.M. Wt. M. with G. Milne for church meeting.

Sat Apr 2: A very nice day
Did chores this morning and went up
home and drew a load of straw and
cleaned out pig pens. Bought down
half load of shaves tonight. Walter to
own with Marcell this aft in some
crab & turn. I fall down tonight
for hair cut.

Sun Apr 3: Coldest today &
hard frost. Walter fixed up car this
morning and all to church by Wilma.
I slept this aft & then to Comp for
supper at 6.30 P.M. Home at 7.30 P.M.

Wed Apr 6: A very nice day. Did chores and split wood this morning and then went home and carried wheat out of basement until 3:30 P.M. and then came home and burnt straw stack & split wood. Not feeling well today tonight so to bed early.

Thurs. Apr 7: Heavy frost again this morning and cloudy all day. Drove to ~~the~~ Oneida this aft & got box full of coal (sour). Home at 4 P.M. Agents for aluminum ware here shortly after and put on supper. Geo & Annie Milne, George & Bessie Gompf, Ruby & Mother all here for supper and talk. Mariel Geo McLean & Geo Smith & Elaine all here after supper. I not feeling well so to bed at supper time. Folks home at 12 A.M.

Friday Apr 8: A cold morning. Unloaded coal this A.M. & then up home this aft & took wheat out of basement & home here at 6 P.M. Chilly afternoon. W-Cartney & Metcalfe here this A.M. and again at noon. To bed early again tonight but feeling better.

Sat Apr 9: Did chores early this A.M. Then up home to make arrangements for days work. Piled & split wood here from 10 A.M. on to 12 A.M. Up horse this aft & cleaned barn all aft while Chalt scraped floor. A lovely night but to bed early.

Sun Apr 10: A lovely day with wind from N. & S. All of us to church in car. Home & up home for dinner & home here at 5 P.M. A lovely moonlight eve. Forty at church this PM.

Mon Apr 11: A beautiful day - warm and mild but a little windy after 4 P.M. from east. I did chores early & got load of barley straw from my brother & then got load of oat sheaves from home. Cleaned grain up from all aft. Kelly Oliver & Morris Forrest drove ~~for~~ what today. I came home at 5:30 & put sheaves up in loft after chores were done.

Tues Apr 12: A warm day. Got load of straw this morning. Went along to Crib with George M. Lush who took up fanning mills & got load of barley. I up home this aft & put in two loads of sheaves. Bea & I up there for supper (Aluminum demonstration) and Mrs & Mr Burley & Miss Short & Anne & C. Carpenter all there for supper.

Wed Apr 13: Another lovely day and some people over the land. Did odd jobs this A.M. and then up home to Cereson wheat this aft. Went to Virden today to Agricultural society meeting & home at 6:30 P.M. Then Joe & George out to Greswoold to whist drive & dance. A beautiful evening. Sold pig to Mr. Knight to-day. Back up working this aft.

Thurs Apr 14: The warmest day of the year so far - 61° above zero. Up home early this A.M. & got live ready & went to dredgers & got package of live & got them into live here. Up home again before noon & helped unload sweet Cloves into loft. Worked at drills this aft. Went away to Greswoold in car at 4:30 P.M. A lovely evening & took Bob & Mac home today & left them.

Tuesday Apr 15: A lovely warm day again and our first start on land. George cultivated east of stable all day with four horses on small cultivator. He oiled harness, fixed drills and got a load of souris coal from Olmetiads. ~~Mauril~~ meeting at home this aft. Cleaned out stable this evening as intend seeding in the morning.

Sat Apr 16: Sowing wheat today in east of barn. Sweet Clover & fertilizer attachments both on drill. Walk up to Recils in car to help fix pump, & home at 2 P.M. He replaced coal this aft & did odd jobs. George cultivated in field next school all day. Mauril & Walter to town in car this aft & Walter, Mauril home at 7 P.M. & 8.30 P.M.

Sun Apr 17: A lovely Easter Sunday. Bea & Mauril I to church in car this A.M. and then on to Kenney at 12.30 P.M. Mauril visited Arnotts while we went on to Pollocks but found them away to Parry. They returned at 8.30 P.M. Bea stayed there & will come home Wed night. Mauril, Laurel Arnott & I returned home at 11.30 P.M.

Mon Apr 18: Got up home at 6 A.M. & sowed all morning in east field (15 acres) Walter took drill & started in 11.30 next school session & came down here & got tractor & took it home. Tried cultivating with big cultivators - but stopped & will try to switch to 1 ft cult in the morning. Mauril & Laurel home tonigh to do dishes & separator. Cool & breezy tonight. Some rain this aft and much thunder. Turning colder tonight

Tues Apr 19: A much colder day with a skiff of snow this morning. So did not get an early start at seeding. It started at 7 A.M. with Gordon cultivating ~~soil~~ in W 80 while George cross harrowed 1/2 acres & Halt did sowing in ~~the~~ W 80 all day. I did odd jobs all aft while George cultivated in W 80 with horses. Maria & Laurel down to-night did dinner for me.

Wed Apr 20: A cold snowy day but we sowed all day. Halt cultivate~~d~~ all the A.M. while George worked cultivated all day & I drilled wheat in W 80. Bea came home to-day. Maria & Laurel took Laurel to Kennedy & then went on to Bow taking Mary with them. A cold night & froze early.

Bua cleaned up summer kitchen today.

Friday April 29 A lovely bright day. Did harrowing till 4 o'clock. Then George took harrows & I went up home & crushed. Walter sowing all day on C 1/4. C. so. George finished cultivating on C 1/4 at 3 o'clock. Dr. Mc Connell up home to test cattle. We were up to home tonight.

Sat Apr. 30 : A lovely bright warm day I cleaned up granary at home this A.M. & got it ready for oats. Paul Hart came back at 12 P.M. & we packed & I all went down to J. J. & Sons at Hummey and got 14 bushels of seed oats. Home at 3.45 P.M. and unloaded them. I then got team & hay rakes and raked garden here. George finished harrowing on C 1/4 this A.M. & cut up potatoes ready for planting

this aft. Hatt sowed wheat on C 1/4 (C 50) all day but didn't finish. George & Hatt to town tonight

Sun May 1 : Sunday School today for first time & church services. A good attendance. Mr. & Mrs. Walter & Mariel stayed for dinner here & until 4.30 P.M. A windy day from east & didn't do very much. Drogging lightly as we go to bed.

Sat May 7: I crushed this AM. and brought down post to. Had early dinner then Bea & I went away to home cooking sale at Oak Lake. Bob Sutherland cut this off & got calf & cows & bought out cow. I fenced most of off. Father sowed oats & George cultivated with tractor in W.S.D. Threshed this off so did not get early start. Beck Goodwin out in truck & got heifers for Dave Milne at St. Paul. A bright day & a little warmer than yesterday.

Sun May 8: Mother's day and all to church. St. David's joined Zion in a very nice service at Cypress. Cecil & family & Bea & I all up home for dinner & supper. music and Bea took third house in car after supper while I did chores.

Mon May 9: A lovely day although cool this morning. I sowed slough with wheat this AM. while Father sowed oats all on 3 & 46 by while George cultivated with tractor in S.W. & 46 & 47 all day. I fenced around fence north of barn at this off ~~seed~~ as well burning straw piles & Russian thistles. Bea & I pulled granary from straw pile but pulled seed from under it. Bea Milne, Mrs. Leo Smith Father & I up to town to church meeting to night. I helped Bea garden & help her buy

Tues May 10: A lovely day and fairly warm. I put up 2 loads of oat sheaves at home & bought a small one down here. I spent a good deal of time getting wife sowed working with horses. Ned finished cultivating 3 acres to night here. Mrs. J. Forrest out at noon

and insured contents of house. Brought up home & washed this A.M.

Tues May 11: A very nice bright day with wind from S.E. all day. I got seedling barley done A.M. on the 4th while George were sowed all day with tractor doing about 30 acres. I helped boys get going and then farmed all day almost finishing tonight. Was doing summer kitchen when A.M. & went to town with married son off taking Uncle J.S. with them to go to Kdn, and then gardened on their return.

Thurs May 13: A miserable windy day blowing legally this morning until 8 A.M. & then blew strongly & dust blowing rest of day. I finished fencing pasture this morning & ran drill this aft. Matt

dulled this P.M. (bulldog 1150 hrs) while George finished wire weeding at noon & started cultivating S.E. 80 after noon. Matt cross sowed 800 on C on the aft. Leon Story took out 53 bush barley for us to be cleaned for our Coop. Land blew considerably this afternoon.

Sunday May 13: Another nasty windy day and fields blew fairly badly. Finished sowing barley on this farm at 3:30 P.M. & sowed wheat in rye field on this 4th in our slough. Sun May 15: I was weeded all day & very nice all to church today. A very nice day. Rained all aft & the two of us up home for supper. Wora there for dinner & supper. Mr Elliott there for dinner. Walt's mother took Wora Shantz home tonight.

Mon May 16: A very nice day. I was weeded all day finishing at 9:30 A.M. & worked here all rest of day

in N.W. Kept horses here at noon but took them home tonight. Walt sowed barley & George cultivated with tractor in S.E. 80. Bea & Marj washed this aft. Mr Kennedy here for short time tonight.

Tues May 17: I was weeded here all day in W. 70. Walt sowed barley & George cultivated with tractor in S.E. 80 all day. A nice cool day.

Wed May 18: Finished sowing barley at noon to day & started sowing oats. Geo. finished cultivating so at noon and then went on over sowed here finishing here at 5 P.M. I did odd jobs tinning the roof on summer kitchen here. Bea went with Marj & mother to St. Davids. Home at 8:30

Thurs May 19: A cool cloudy day I went to town this morning in car and got magnets fixed for tractor & then crashed this aft. Walter finished sowing the oats for green feed at noon. George wire weeded all day in S.E. 80. Hatt raked Russian thistle in field next Milnes this afternoon. Rained a little last night but soon dry.

Friday May 20: I helped Ba garden then fixed fence & did odd jobs all morning. Hatt raked Russian thistle in E. 80 all morning while Geo wire weeded in S.E. 80 all day. I burned bush in E. 80 all aft. finishing all he had raked. Cim over for 34 bush early this aft. A very nice day & warm. Geo Hatt & Merle the boys to play tonight.

Sat May 21: A warmer day

I burned a little brush this morning Ba Marcell & I to Granitor in car this aft & home at 12:30 A.M. Geo weeded all day while Hatt burned bush & did odd jobs.

Sun May 22: A very nice warm day I church this morning and slept most of this aft. Walter down for a short time this evening & then all of us up home until 10:30 P.M. A lovely evening

Mon. May 23: Frost this morning but did no damage done. Fairly cool all day though mostly bright. I raked Russian thistle in E. 80 all morning while Hatt worked at tractor & did odd jobs I worked at screen doors down here until 3 P.M. & then burned thistle this aft while Hatt raked. George weeded S.E. 80 and finished at 5 P.M. Cool again tonight

Tues May 24: A cool day with wind from west and partly cloudy. I did odd jobs here for a time this A.M. & then went up home. Thurs May 26: Cool this morning & warmer this aft. Hattie painted the A.M. and part of this afternoon & then cultivated with horses in E.S. I cultivated all day until 4 P.M. then burned this in C¹/4. George raked all day. Spent though this afternoon.

Friday May 27: I cultivated in E 80 all day Hattie painted in house and did odd jobs. George raked and burned in C¹/4 finishing tonight. A fairly strong wind all day from south.

Sat May 28: I cultivated in E 80 on C¹/4 all day until 4.30 P.M. when I came home & then came home here at 5.30 for supper. Mr. Parker & Mr. Gaskins of Alexander mother & Ruby here for tea. Parker away home at 8 P.M. Then road milking at 9.30 P.M. Hattie &

George away to Didsbury to show tonight.
George Smith here to get folks tonight.
George M. raked in S.E. 20 acres all
day & burned Russian thistle. Walter
planted in fence all day. A little
shower at 6 P.M.

Sun. May 29: A lovely day. Walter
and Muriel took Miss Short up to
her home at Petropies this aft.
Mrs. & Mrs. Pollock, Jack Florence,
Muriel & Marg-Rose, all here at 1 P.M.
& stayed until 7 P.M. for supper and
dinner.

Tues May 31: A very nice day. I

Wed June 8: I cultivated with tractor in field (summer fallow) north east of buildings here and finished at 11.50 A.M. Hattie did odd jobs this A.M. while George worked on the road. This aft I did odd jobs at home this aft while Hattie went on the road and George went to town with the folks and got his teeth attended to. Cecil down for a load of oats this aft. George came and got old horse engine and Gladnet Vance came with a bottle of distillate. I brought car home with me tonight.

Thurs June 9: A cool cloudy morning. Did some chores up home & then came down here & did odd jobs here & in gardens. Started to rain at noon and by 4 P.M. fell pretty hard. George

and I tore up a stall at home ready to repair & I cleaned out pigs stalls to town with team & hemmed in rain taking out mower and bringing home planking. George got in 1/2 day on road this A.M. Ladies missionary meeting here this aft. Drizzled a little after supper but clearing as we go to bed. The rain saved the crops.

Friday June 10: Worked out down here most of morning cleaning potatoes out of cellar. George put floor in stall this A.M. while Halters clipped small hedges & hedge. George went on road this aft. Miss Shabt called up home this evening. A bright mild day.

with stroke. Walt got Bert Hicks made
trip to town. Then I to Bea & I took

him back to Montgomery at 8.30 P.M. Uncle

Todd to Gordon Todd's for the aft.
A lovely cool evening.

Wed June 22nd: Fairly cool day.
Walt load in garden & did odd jobs
all day while I put my crank in
binder & fixed it up for cutting clover.

lovely evening.

Thurs June 23rd: A cool day
and cloudy. Walt & I cut sweet clover

Friday June 24: A nice cool cloudy day. Walter & I cut clover in SW 20 all day with Fredon but did not finish - about 1/2 is more to do. George worked all day in E 80. Mother, Mrs. Todd, Marcell & ~~Walter~~ went to town this aft & visited Mrs. Sherman for her. Marcell, Walter & George up to picnic at J. Smith's tonight. - last day of school.

Sat June 25: A little warmer today but cool. Walt & I finished cutting Sweet Clover at his place at 10 A.M. & then came down here & finished the 6 acres here at 1 P.M. Walter here for dinner - left binder here but took tractor home. I stocked this aft in sweet Clover here & Walt stocked at home. George finished weeding in East 80 at 4 P.M. & then helped stock out clover. Bea & I to town with Walter tonight.

Sun June 26: Did not go to church but rested. May Dollock, Minnie & Bell Buckley here for supper & the ^{evening} ~~afternoon~~. Bebe down home for dinner & here for a short time. We left. A lovely day & evening - fairly cool.

Mon June 27: Stocked sweet Clover here this morning & cut clover in SW 20 this aft. D. Gilham Jr. came for 10 bushels of oats this A.M. George cultivated all morning in summerfallow here & then went to C₄ & cultivated summerfallow there all aft. Lou Story out this aft so Walt helped him fix lat tractor but did not finish tonight. Walter took after up to bed - ring after supper & home at 10 P.M.

Tues June 28: A cool cloudy day & no little shower at 11 A.M. I finished stocking sweet Clover here at 9.30 A.M. & spent rest of day stocking at home in SW. 20. Walter crushed with tractor this aft. & then helped me stock. Boa & Muriel roosted this morning. Ruby likes rain tonight.

Wed June 29: A cloudy morning & cool but a bright hot afternoon. Walt & I finished stocking sweet clover at home this A.M. Walt went to town in car this aft while I mowed around ^{rooftop} hay and barley. George cultivated on C of all day. Walt down for a time this evening and will leave for Moose Jaw tomorrow morning. Wind S.E. all day. He set out tomato & cabbage plants tonight.

Thurs June 30: A very warm day. Walter left at 9 A.M. for Moose Jaw taking Ruby & Blaine with him. I haked up sweet clover until 3.30 P.M. and then mowed yard here and sweet clover along fence in 6 acres. George cultivated on C ^{top} all day but did not finish. Ruby this A.M. rainy but clear & hot rest of day. Cloudy tonight & wind still S.E. Need in garden tonight.

Friday July 1: A shower this morning at 4 A.M. and filled the tank but only went down about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. Up at 6 A.M. and over home at 8 A.M. George away to sports at Oak Lake. I cleaned out stables & did odd jobs at home & cultivated potatoes here. Singer sewing machine man here at noon. I finished cultivating on C ^{top} this aft. started in E 10. Mr. McLeod home this aft. I did chores at home and here tonight finishing at 8.30 P.M.

Wed July 3: A warm ^{dry} day.
Had to take Jerry cow to Merricks
this A.M. but had to come back without
out getting there. George cultivated
rest of morning in east 80 while

jobs here - sowing turnips etc. He

6 loads today making 1/2 stacks. Close
and cloudy tonight and very hot this aft.
Bis & I sat on front steps after watering
& hoeing in garden.

Tues July 5: A heavy rain
storm last night. George & I took
rake apart and did odd jobs this
A.M. I went to town in Merricks
this aft. and got shars & coke parts
home at 5.30 P.M. Tom Bowes & family
visiting up home this aft & the night
(from Birnie). Walter home from home
now at 7.30 and then came down
here for the evening. Rained all the
time he was here and yard full of
water. Smutting flocked chickens last
night so put them all in low house

to night except turkeys which we put in drive shed. Rain ceased off at 10.30 P.M. I'm visiting at home tonight. A hot afternoon.

Boeve family away to Brandon Sat 9 A.M. their turkeys taken last night in drive shed by ~~concerned~~ ^{concerned} cool tonight.

Thur. July 7: A lovely cool day with wind from N. W. I went to Clarence Kennedy's in car with Uncle Tom this morning, got hogs and dead pigs. Ialt plowed ground potatoes all day while I mowed road allowance finishing north side of & west of some place. George plowed this A.M. ~~etc~~ & went to Brandon this aft. to fair.

Friday July 8: Another lovely day. I mowed on road allowance all day finishing altogether tonight. George got home from Bdn at 9 A.M. & plowed rest of day in S.E. 20. (closed) Ialt worked in garden. Mariel down & went with Bea & Mariel to pick raspberries on C.R. A lovely evening.

Sat July 9: Rained ~~most~~ ^{all} day but got rain & over a heavy shower at 1 P.M. So I crushed this morning and drew load around to crop house. I also had in potatoes all day while George split wood. I put posts in around 4 acre pasture south of granary. I got Bill Drayton at noon in car and went through live & feed on 3rd box. All of us into town tonight. B&I to show (Hurricane) & a lovely time.

Sun July 10: A beautiful day. bright and dry. Ab to church this A.M. Mrs. Todd knocked record. Old & Muriel down after supper until after 8 P.M. A lovely sunset. Halt away for the evening.

Mon July 11: A moderately warm (81°) day with wind from south. I raked hay on road all day finishing at 5:45 P.M. Halt & I sat in garden this morning and cultivated summer-fallow here this aft. George cultivated in Barn 80 all day with 6 horses. A lovely evening.

Tues July 12: A very nice day bright & warm this morning but cool & strong wind from north west this aft. Uncle T.J. took Muriel and Mrs. Todd to Clear Lake this A.M. & Beatrice went with them as far as Kenney. Mrs. Todd stayed at Clear Lake & others arrived home at 9:15 P.M. Halt & I got in hay all day off road allowance 4 loads to day. Some storey out to see tractor to day's car. George cultivated with 6 horses in 80 all day.

Wed July 13: A lovely cool day with strong wind from N.W. Hattie & I got in a load of hay off North West road but had to quit on account of wind so went at sweet Clover sheaves. Stopped George cultivating at noon & I was stacked all aft. Hattie, Bea & Aunt Lizzie out home & docon here for short time.

Thurs July 14: Warmer to-day and 3 of us kept on stacking sweet Clover all day finishing at 5.30 P.M. I saw Hattie & Aunt Lizzie out home for supper tonight. Bea & I kept there for supper too. A lovely evening.

Friday July 15: I stacked up down sheaves in my sweet Clover lots & M. and then got some live feed from home and brought down 2 supers for live. Went

through bus & feet on fourth super. Hattie cultivated with tractor here all morning & ran it all afternoon. Hattie attended seed growers meeting at Oak Lake this afternoon. George cultivated with horses in east 80 all day. Bea & I over to Anne Carpenter's tonight to audit books for school. Home at 11.30 P.M.

Sat July 16: Hattie & I got hay in off road this morning. Then we went into town this aft to see for fair grounds. George cultivated all A.M. & then helped me with hay, finishing road at 3 P.M. & then went on cultivating. I came down here & cultivated with tractor finishing at 6.45 P.M. Hattie & George away to town tonight. Bea & I worked in garden until 9.30 P.M.

Sun July 19: A very nice day
Did not go to closed the A.M.
but read & slept. Mr & Mrs Dolek
Rozelle & Tim Denneyman & wife
lun this aft & for supper, left
at 9 P.M. A lovely day.

Mon July 20: A very nice day
Halt George & I got up all the
several clover sheaves here & put them

team finishing at 10:45. George were

aft. A fairly good fair & a nice time
Home at 7 P.M. Rained from 3 P.M.
to 4:30 P.M.

Wed July 20: Another showy day
Rained this A.M. so I washed all
A.M. doing a load for Tim & one for me.
Halt hoed in gardens this A.M. & feed
binders and crushed this aft. I doed in
garden here all aft & George were
weeded here all day. Bea helped
Marie pick raspberries this aft. &
shower at 3:30 P.M.

Yours July 21: A lovely day fair & bright. Polly took the disease encephalomyelitis this morning so we got Bert Kicks & I spent much of the day treating her. Fixed binder & canvas most of day & rouged wheat. Walter cultivated on C₄ all day doing about 30 acres with tractor. George wire weeded here all day. A lovely evening & I went up home at 9 P.M. to see Polly. Walter down here at 8 P.M. to get hair cut.

Tuesday July 22: Another nice dry day. I drove tractor cultivator this morning on C₄ @ 6:50 finishing it at noon. (50 acres in 12 hrs.) Did weeding in C₂₀ after dinner finishing it at 6:30 P.M. George finished wire weeded here at 10 A.M. & then went in C₈₀ with all day. Walter just sat binders all day aft. but finished rouging wheat

Mrs. Stees & Hedges out picking raspberries to-day.

Wednesday 23: Fairly warm this A.M. but cool N.W. wind this aft. Walter worked at separator & binders all day. I got plow & tractor ready this A.M. & burned around sweet clover field here and then plowed here with tractor this aft. almost finishing tonight. Bea Marcell & I to town tonight in car. George mowed oats in strips & hopped weeds down here & cultivated potatoes off horses aft @ 2:30.

Thursday July 24: We cleaned to-day as Marcell & Bea Marion & I went to lake in car this aft & home at 9:45 P.M. Walter did over chores. A lovely day & evening.

Tues July 25: A very nice warm day I finished plowing with tractor & then cultivated sloughs here & went up home taking binder. Fired binders & separator all day George was weeded all day in 880. Marion & Mrs. Aikens son picking raspberries to-day & has up this aft.

Tues July 26: Dull & cloudy all day and a drizzling afternoon. Hatt & I fixed at binders and separator all day. I went to Charles in east to get a bearing he brought from town last night. George was weeded with horse in 880 all day. Mr & Mrs. Saltman were round & up home for supper. He went to bed early. Air full of moisture but clear.

Wed July 27: I worked with Hatt at separator until 9 A.M. and then George & I went to town in car getting repairs etc. Home at 12.15 P.M. I tried cutting this aft but started to rain when I rounds around 5 acre Renown wheat plot. George side weeded 25 acres this aft with tractor & weeded this A.M. with horse. Hatt worked at separator all day. Mrs J. Aikens & family out picking raspberries this aft. Uncle Tom, Mother & Maria up to Montgomery the day after

Thurs July 28: A nice calm warm bright day. Damp until noon so did not start to cut until 1.45 P.M. Cut the 5 acres of Renown wheat & 2 acres of Thatcher by night. Mother up to town with Uncle G. in his car this aft. George chores around this A.M. & was weeded with tractor in 880 on 1/4 the A. Hatt

worked at separator most of day & stocked around 5 acres. Muriel Bea & Margaret picked cherries on C⁴ today.

Friday July 29: A lovely dry day with a light shower at 1 P.M. Started cutting in 12 acres at 9 A.M. but had very poor day as compass & knotted gave trouble. Walt moved binder to A.H. & stocked & fixed binder this aft. George finished harvesting on C⁴ at 4.30 P.M. Muriel to town this aft. in car.

Sat July 30: I finished cutting 15 acres of wheat back of stable at 10.30 A.M. and then came over & finished breaking in the bluffs before night. George & Walter finished cutting green oats at 4.30 P.M. with tractor & then

came over here & got seven acres rounded around 40 acres here. Rained this evening after seven P.M. Walter and George away to town in car tonight.

Sun July 31: A hot sultry day until 4.30 P.M. when large hail fell. Causing 55% damage at least. Barley flat. Shorts of Oak River down for afternoon. Walt & George down to lake this aft & not home at 10 P.M.

Monday Aug 1st - Warm & close this aft. noon. Stocked most of day around wheat. Walt & George stocked in 12 acres all day. Ground very damp this morning, but dried up around noon. No cutting done. Neighbors cutting with binders & saving 50% of wheat.

Tues Aug 2nd: A small shower this morning so did not start cutting until 9:30 A.M. though cutting went out of wheat at 3 P.M. and started cutting barley with tractor. Got 7 rounds around 55 acres west. Hattie went to town at 1:30 P.M. & got repairs for tractor binder. Bought home combine expert who advised combining wheat. Hattie went up to Cecil to see how about doing wheat and home at 3:30 P.M. & out at separator rest of day. Rained heavily at 8:00 P.M. and it is again as we go to bed.

Wed Aug 3rd: A dry windy day but ground too wet to seed. Rained quite a little through the night. I stooked barley up late & then went at wheat & got around wheat but still breaking

still to do. Mooney Barris schemes here tonight & we purchased combine. A lovely moonlight night. Home late & to bed at 10:30 P.M.

Thurs Aug 4th: Another lovely day with strong wind from east. I stooked wheat this aft & helped Hattie fix separator this morning. George cut wheat ^{bedding} all night Hattie fixed at separator & went to see Ken & Hattie Bain in car. Muriel took Margaret to town today & left late. A lovely evening.

Fri Aug 5th: A lovely cool bright day. I stooked this morning as well as helped Hattie fix off separator. George cut barley this AM and then stooked this aft until 4 P.M. (in wheat, finishing it) and then went with Hattie and sweater at George combine Smith. I cut barley all aft. Slew a red

Sat Aug 6: A somewhat showery day this aft. I took tractor & combine up to Clarence's (Good place) & brought tractor back at 11 A.M. Bob Montgomery got going with his tractor on our combine & worked until rain stopped him at 3 P.M. He started Thatcher & Renovon today. Renovon went 34蒲m. Rain stopped us with Thatcher at 16蒲m. Clarence & man up helping us & George a J.

Sun Aug 7: A lovely day until night when looks like rain but not much. I went to church this A.M. but rested this aft. Mr & Mrs. Bullock here at 6 P.M. and Tim & May. In at 8 P.M. Mother & myself here too as Walter went to town. All away home at 10 P.M. Lightning & thunder abound.

Mon Aug 8: Walter took George up to Clarence's (Good place) & he combined there all day with Bob Montgomery on his engine. Walter there most of shooting & when he creaked all afternoon & fixed separators. I cut barley all day here and will finish in couple of more hours. Just at 6 P.M. & came home & did chores then went up home & helped Walter get tractor fixed up. Home at 9.30 P.M. Dry all day with east wind. Cloudy tonight.

Tues Aug 9: Walt & I got tractor fixed with new take-off this morning & Walt took up to Clarence's Good place getting started combining after 11 A.M. I took George up & came home at 10.30 A.M. with car. Then went shooting grew oats until noon. After dinner I cut barley at 3 P.M. & finished at 8.30 P.M. when rain shower started. Boys came home at 4 P.M. married to

Took at 10.30 A.M. & got car fixed. Rained until 4.30 P.M. when wind blew from north - a nice evening

Wed. Aug 10: A beautiful day all day. Hattie & Sol Falls worked at ~~bailed~~ combine most of day finishing at 4 P.M. I also put barley in rows here all day & George stacked green oats this A.M. & helped put barley in rows this aft. Finished at 7 P.M. A beautiful evening.

Thurs Aug 11: A nice warm dry day. Boys got combine going at 9.30 A.M. but had trouble through the day and was not home yet at 9.20 P.M. I took wagon up to them this morning and then moved oak sloughs rest of day. Cecil took our car out to town this aft to see his house which is sick

Ina & Mariana went down for supper. I did chores at home & here tonight.

Friday Aug 12: Hattie & George got going with combine at 8 A.M. & got in a very good day doing 370 bushels on C. Kennedy's place. I took team to Hes. Mdnes & threshed there all day came home at 4 P.M. & did chores at mother's. Muriel & Bea did chores here & there came up there. Bea & I had dinner here at 10 P.M.

Sat Aug 13: Boys got going early on combine this A.M. & got in well. Finished cleaning at 4 P.M. & then did Rev. Doherty's six acres by 6 P.M. & did a round for Tom Montgomery and brought machine home at 8 P.M. Like rain tonight - warm & cool. I threshed all day with Bea, milne at his

place but are only $\frac{3}{4}$ thru & 2 acre field
did chores after I got home at mothers.

Tues Aug 14: Rained most of
night last night so and cloudy most
of today so still, damp tonight cool
it rained again from 8 P.M. to 10.30 P.M.
I took my Red cows home & from there
Walter walked with me to Mrs Merricks
home at 12 P.M. Spent part of the aft at
mothers then came home here. Doris Bell
& Roy came at 5 P.M. for supper. Jack
and Florence & Margaret Rose came
up at 7.30 P.M. Muriel & Walter came
down. Every one home at 11 P.M. A
lovely evening.

Wed Aug 15: I spent most of
morning looking after Prince (black
horse bought from Charlie Smith) but
has he will die. I spent afternoon

extracting honey until 5 P.M. Then
stocked wheat. Leo fixed fence until
noon & helped with horses. Then after noon
cultivated patches of cloths here in summer
fallow. Still cleaning up honey at
9.15 P.M. and will have about twenty
bars lbs.

Thurs Aug 16: Dry this morning
but ground still damp. George went
up to Cecilia this A.M. & will be a few
days stocking - Walter worked at hedges
all day finishing them this aft. I herded
black horse this morning & stocked wheat
cut since laid on this farm. A heavy
shower at 5 P.M. Leo & I to town in
car tonight. Roads very muddy.

Fri Aug 17: Stocked out 2 loads of
sheep. In morning & got load of wheat

ready for Walter to take to town this
afternoon I finished stocking about the
aft at 4 P.M. & then ~~ended~~ until 6 P.M.
Bright & dry all day.

Thurs Aug 18: - A warm day but a
cooling shifting. I got up soon after
to day & got two forty cultivated here
with six horses. Halt crushed a little
more this A.M. and did odd job getting
every thing ready to go combining this aft.
Muriel got George from Crows at noon
& Halt and he got away at 1:30 P.M. &
not home yet at 9 P.M. A nice afternoon.
I did chores up home this evening.

Friday Aug 19: - A nice cool
morning with wind from N.W. I
cultivated in 40 acre here (summafallow)
with 6 horses. Stopped at 11 A.M. and

got early start to Hes Moines and threshed
peast all afternoon almost finishing
tonight when it rained fairly heavily
at 4:45 P.M. Boys got going with combine
at 10 A.M. and worked steadily all day.
but had to quit at 6 P.M. because of rain.
Much more rain went round less than

Sat Aug 20: - Got this A.M. so Halt

fallow at 11 A.M. kept going until 9 P.M.
and got 40 acres done. George cultivated
here in 40 acre summafallow & finished at 5 P.M.
I fed truck toseal this morning & find windaw

and did odd jobs here & up home this aft. Some people threshing this aft but rather windy.

Sun Aug 21: A lovely bright cool day. Rester down early this morning & got haircut. He & Mother & Marid to church. Jack Florence & Marg. Rose up here at 11.30 A.M. in car and all of us up to Demota in his car. Halt and Marid did chores here & then start away for the evening. We got home at 10 P.M. A lovely day. Geo M'Klus at home to-day.

Mon Aug 22: Another lovely bright cool day. Boys combined at Geo. Smith's all day and got along well. I cultivated in & up home all day doing about 18 acres. Bea up helping Marid wash to-day. And Lizzie Hattie & Nancy out home for supper tonight. I did chores up home & then came home here & finished up here at 9 P.M.

Tues Aug 23: Worked all day at home and here. Finished at home at 3.30 P.M. and worked here until 7 P.M. Halt & George finished combining at Geo. Smith's & brought machine home. Carl & George down threshing all day.

Wed Aug 24: A very nice day until 4 P.M. when it rained. Halt & I got combine fixed with S.P. Fall & got combining after dinner. Took a sample in to town with S.P. & found it too damp so will have to scratch. Geo Milne threshed threshing at 4 P.M. here. I got 360 bush (cleaned) off this land ~~as~~ already cut & stacked. Undecided as yet what we will do with our time and our crop. Windy tonight from west.

Thurs Aug 25th Worked on summer fallow all day while Geo & Walt finished up combine to go to Ken D. Montgomery's got away around 1/2 30. Ken here to do swathing here around 11th over to Waller 80 acres. I cultivated at home all day finishing 80 acres east at 7 P.M. and started S.E. 20. Fixed fence in right pasture at noon. Then broke tractor at 5 P.M. and left in car. George & Walter finished Ken's crop at 2.30 P.M. and started at Montgomery's. Still going at 8.30 P.M.

Friday Aug 26th A lovely bright day & warm. Ken D. finished swathing here around 11th over to Waller 80 acres. I cultivated at home all day finishing 80 acres east at 7 P.M. and started S.E. 20. Fixed fence in right pasture at noon. Then broke tractor at 5 P.M. and left in car. George & Walter finished Ken's crop at 2.30 P.M. and started at Montgomery's. Still going at 8.30 P.M.

Sat Aug 27: I cultivated all day at home getting the S.E. 20 half finished and the garden summerfallowed west of trees. A. Doherty swathed all day from 9 A.M. until 6 P.M. in W 80. George & Walt combined all day and got on very well at Tom Montgomery's. Left out and fixed combine so Walter is able to run it alone. George left home at 6.30 P.M. and all of us into town to see Shirley Temple. A lovely day and evening.

Sunday Aug 28: A lovely day bright and warm. I went to church with Mother & Muriel in car. Home at 1.10 P.M. Walter here for dinner & then away home at 3 P.M. Ben & I milked early & went to bush for a walk. Walt away for the evening.

Tues Aug 29: Another bright day with strong wind from south around noon but calmed after 4 P.M. Walt finished combining at Montgomery's ~~till~~ this aft. & then started at Geo Milne's barley. Went to Oak Lake at 1:15 P.M. to get some repairs for combine. Geo & Muriel at Cecil all day to help threshing but they had to stop because of wind at noon. A lovely evening.

Tues Aug 30: Another lovely bright day - cool in morning but warmer this aft. I cultivated on C^{1/4} full day. Ken did not get swathing until this aft because of worn bearing in roller of swather. Walt combined at Geo. Milne's all day finishing at 5:30. Worked there here until 6:30 P.M. turning out about 5 bush. Geo Milne helping Walt on combine. Geo in field at 6:30 a.m.

Wed Aug 31: A lovely day. I cultivated on C^{1/4} C 50 all day (when no yellow) Geo Milne & Walter here for dinner and finished combining here at 4 P.M. and then went on into H. 80 at home. Geo & Walt still at Cecil. A lovely evening. S.P. Fall and Warren & wife home this afternoon.

Thurs Sept 1: Another lovely day, bright and warm. Combine got going at 10:30 A.M. but ran well all day & until 8:30 P.M. I cultivated all day. Got thru chores at 8:30 P.M. A lovely moonlight night. We painted floor this A.M. up in bedroom.

Fri Sept 2: Another lovely day I cultivated this A.M. on C^{1/4} after taking Jersey cow to the Merricks. Geo Milne worked on combine with Walter until noon and then I went on it. Not finished cultivating yet. A lovely evening.

Sat Sep 3: Another lovely bright dry day. Halt & I got going at about 8:30 A.M. with combine in least 80 and finished at 3:45 P.M. Went down to C.H.C. 50 wheat at 4:00 P.M. and got 4 rounds done before 7 P.M. Hung very well. Bed with Russian thistle but nice and dry & going very well. George home this evening but not finished threshing straw yet. (at Cecile) Muriel & Mother out to town this aft. taking Glen Milow.

Sun Sep 4: A lovely day. Bea & I both stayed home all day & read & slept. Mother & Muriel to church. Halt away at 4 P.M. for supper. George home & to do chores all day. I was up home for a few minutes after supper.

Mon Sep 5: Halt & I combined steadily all day in C 50 on C 49 and finished there tonight. George up at

George Smith all day and finished tonight. Bea up home for afternoon & evening but home for chores. Halt & I home at 7:30 & do chores at 8:30 P.M. A lovely evening but looks a little like rain.

Tues Sept 6: A baby girl born to us at 2:40 A.M. Every one quite well. Mrs. Coopers out looking after Bea (I got her in car at midnight) Halt brought home combine this A.M. & we both brought down threshing out fit & after dinner Cecile came down & we threshed with three teams and got eighty bushels of barley threshed blowing straw into loft. George cultivated this morning on C 49.

Wed Sep 7: Geo. Smith's man came down this morning and with Cecil, Stanley & Geo McLeish made four teams. Moved away from loft line at 3 P.M. and stacked west of stable in W.S. Cecil & Stanley went home tonight but Henry stayed overnight. A lovely evening. Did about 250 bushels to-day.

Thurs Sep 8: A damp air & cloudy this A.M. but finished stacking at 11:30 A.M. Stacked green oat leaves this aft. A lovely evening & drew chores at 8:30 P.M. Ed & Wong brought out man to fix up radio this aft.

Friday Sep 9: I went to town in car this A.M. (while boys stacked) & got settlant A.M. & salt away this evening for wheat. Drove at noon. He all stacked this aft. Hatt & George away to Kinton tonight.

Cloudy & rainy this morning but not too wet to stack.

Sat Sep 10: A cloudy foggy morning so George finished cultivating on C.H. while Hatt & I unloaded barley got separator away & crushed. George & I finished stacking the aft in light rain but not enough to stop us. Hatt up to fish with tractor & I worked for him.

Sun Sep 11: A nice day fair and warm. Did not go to church to-day but stayed home with Bea & baby. M.W. & M.W. Pollack Rosella & Mr. Honeyman and Marjorie Black all up this aft & stayed until 2:30 P.M. Bea Marjorie Ruth Lyman and Helen Milne all

Mon Sep 12: A lovely day. Fall like but leaves not turning yet. I raked up drayton which were down to oats & George & I got in 3 loads this aft. Very poor fed. Got out & weeded with tractor at Cecils all day but will come home tonight. I paid fence next Merricks this aft. Muriel Mother Connie Milne & Ethel Kennedy up to Cecils to missionary meeting this aft.

Tues Sep 13: A lovely bright warm day but morning and evening cool. George & I got in rest of oats from drayton while Walter went to Cecils and got tractor this morn wrote letters. I went to town this aft with some wheat in wagon & brought home servery Ruby, Ethel our folks and Uncle Tom & Aunt Lizzie out here to see baby this aft. Through stores at 9 P.M. - a lovely evening

Wed Sep 14: Another lovely fall day. Unloaded screenings this morning and then turned wheat stubble rest of day. George raked russias double patches this A.M. and cleaned in W. 80 this aft. Walter did odd jobs this A.M. and went to Mr. Montgomery's funeral this aft. Frost this morning but not severe.

Thurs Sep 15: Another lovely day. Cloudy this morning so no frost. I burned in W. 80 all day finishing at 5 P.M. Home at 5:45 in car and took Mrs Cooper to town at 8 P.M. Warmed down & looked up to Bear. Saw up for first time today. Mr & Mrs Pollock May, Florence, Mary Rose, & Leila Pollock all arrived here at 8:30 P.M. to visit & may well stay a few days.

Fri Sep 16: A nice bright day. Went up to Cecils to market hay all day. Diced in W. 80 all day. I crushed this

A. H. did odd jobs this aft. Got vegetables from garden tonight for fear of frost.

Sat. Sept. 17 - Walt & I got in oats from slough. Geo. worked on summer fallows. Slacked them by. stable. Marjorie & Bea worked around house. Ralph & Marjorie got in vegetables & covered up some.

Sun Sep 18: A lovely day. Marge to rally day service with our folks in Oak Lake - and home at 8 P.M. Picnic dinner in town & supper at Mother's. Bea & I alone all day. Thought chills at 8:50 P.M. or ~~time~~ frost this morning and most of the garden frozen.

Mon Sep 19: A very nice day but a heavy frost this morning and everything in the garden is black. A lovely day with wind from south. Walt got potato digger from Leo Smith this morning. We dug potatoes all day getting not quite 200 of them ~~up~~. Warm bright. Geo. dined in ~~west~~ 80 seas all day.

Tues Sep 20: A beautiful day. Set up potatoes until 3:30 P.M. and then two of us up to Gordon Kennedy in car to Gordon demonstration. Came home & dug up all potatoes here & at home and will take digger home tomorrow morning. Marjorie out to town with Marie & Ralph in car to hear Edna Jacques.

Wed Sep 21: A lovely hot day - almost too hot. Walter & I finished digging potatoes up home at 3.30 P.M. and then came down here and finished at 6 P.M. leaving potatoes in wagons at cellar window. George diced in W.D.s all day. A warm evening & Marj. up to Merricks for supper. To bed at 9.30 P.M.

Thurs Sep 22: A lovely hot summer like day (88° above at noon). I took cows to Merricks and unloaded potatoes this morning and burned what stubble east of house here this aft. Walter did odd jobs all day & went to town at 5 P.M. taking Marj. He & Anna Taylor went to Brandon at 7 P.M. & took Marj. home to Henning. A lovely evening.

Friday Sep 23: A lovely day again. Walter & I did odd jobs this morning getting binders away - packing in separate bags - crosssing etc while George diced and finished in west 80 with horses. George diced here east of house with tractor all aft & almost finished while Walter & I burned stubble in C. 30 on C. 4. So hot early tonight. Marj. up to Brandon tonight to choir practice for anniversary services.

Sat Sep 24: A warm day with strong wind from south. George finished driving in field east of house here at 11 A.M. I drew home seeds and did odd jobs. Then both of us sowed some Rennow wheat for Walter took team to town for load of coal & home at 11.5 P.M. with 2800 lbs. All 3 of us down to C. 4 to burn stubble this aft and burned all but standing grain. Walter then raked field west of house & George burned while I cleaned out coal here. A lovely evening.

Sun Sep 25: Another lovely fall day and our anniversary services. I went to church with folks while Bea stayed at home with baby. Both of us ^{got} up home this aft & visited with Wilfred & family who were there for dinner. Grand nieces Mrs. Eckman & Mrs. Rothrock also there for dinner. A lovely afternoon & evening.

Mon Sep 26: Another bright dry day - air rather smoky and strong breeze from N.W. this aft. I unloaded rest of coal here & then went up home & fixed up tires on car then came home here & took wire off pasture fence ready for moving. Walter raked all day in W80 (Russian thistle). George spread manure with spreader all day. Sent Bill over radio today.

Tues Sep 27: A dry day with fresh winds from N.W. but dark & cloudy with smoke from bush fires. I pulled out posts on east side of pasture north of the stable & did odd jobs this AM while Walter went to Oak Lake to care taking Uncle Tom. George spread manure all day. Walter & I raked & burned stubble west of the aft. Through chores at 8.45 P.M.

Wed Sep 28: Another warm calm day. I burned stubble in W88 all day. George hauled manure from piles in yard all day & finished to 7.5. Walter raked up stubble in W80 which I burned it. George & Walter down at noon & helped me move into winter kitchen. Muriel's mother called on way to see at Mrs. Elliott in Oak Lake & I fixed this tire. At last evening

Thurs Sep 29: Another lovely day. We finished raking burning this morning

George cultivated sweet Clover plowed land north of stable here & did patches of ditch in summer fallow set on the place George cultivated on C 50 on C $\frac{1}{4}$ this aft. Walt & I plied east of house here this aft. Mother & Mairie up to Ryerson Church to thank offering meeting.

Friday Sep 30: A lovely day with wind from south frosty this morning but soon warm. I planted posts all day and got in quite a few east of house from very dry or hard. Aunt Sophie & Bebe out home but did not call here. Bebe took a walk up home this aft. Walt & George up to Kenton tonight to show "Snowmen & snow dwarfs"

Sat Oct 1: Another dry lovely day Got wagon ready for pigs this aft.

and got away to town with 6 pigs weighing 1310 lbs. Brought home 11 bags of flour & for ourselves and 7 for home folks. George, Walter came home with me and took loads up to Kenton to shoe in our car. Walter & George got wood home from Mrs. Merrieks Bluff on hill this aft & this aft through chores at 9 P.M.

Sun Oct 2: A very nice smoky day and warm. I went to church with folks taking Anne Wilcox & Glenn. Communion Sunday. Ben & I up home for dinner & home at 6.30 P.M. Walter away for supper while George did chores. Mr. & Mrs. Black Jack Florence Marjorie & Mary Rose here at 7.30 P.M. & got the evening.

Mon Oct 3: Another smoky warm day I brought down flour (4 bags) here in lantern & then brought in vegetables from garden

citrons carrots beets melons etc. Put in fence posts rest of morning & until 3.30 P.M. George & Halters got load of wood this A.M. from Geo Merleick. They then bagged potatoes for sale to Geo Taylor. I helped finish up & then came back to fence. Geo M. went shooting ducks. Halt did odd jobs. Geo finished at our place tonight. A. Harvey's barn took fire at 6 P.M. & we all went over but been gone by 7.15 P.M. through snow at 9 P.M.

Tues Oct 5: Cooler today & dark and cloudy all day. Halters spent all morning at Harvey's cleaning up after fire, & planted posts all day and made brace posts. Halters fixed windows this aft & roof. Stanley & Garry Lee this evening for visit until 10 P.M.

Wed Oct 6: Halters away to work on road west of school at 9.30 A.M. & worked there all day coming home at noon with team. I brought Halters down this A.M. & drove over three strands of wire from fence north of town with single tree. Bill Collock & his Club men here at noon. Men & ladies of district out to Lena Taylor's this afternoon.

Thurs Oct 7: Dark & cloudy all day & like rain at times. I worked at fence all day while Halters worked on road. Mother & Maria went to 16 Hills this aft to quilting Bee. Harvey tonight.

Friday Oct 8: Up home at 7 A.M. & helped Halters get away on road. Did chores there then came home & did chores here. Rained rest of day & ge Halters up some & washed clothes with Mariel this aft until 5 P.M. & then came home & ~~went~~ fenced.

Newspat Magazine agent in this aft. A lovely day and evening. Bea had baby up to Mothers for a time this aft. Mother away with Uncle T.J. to J.R. Todd's this aft.

Sat Oct 8: A lovely bright day I fence most of day here & then drove up home - and finished fencing. Hatt put in last day on road quitting at 5:30 P.M. Hatt & I into town tonight taking the Smiles two now. A lovely evening.

Sun Oct 9: Bea to church with folks this morning while I minded baby. Both of us up home this aft. Bea not feeling well tonight (flu). Hatt away for the evening. A beautiful warm fall like day.

Mon Oct 10: Bea better this aft but pretty dopey this AM. I did chores up home

while Hatt did another days work on the road & finished tonight. Came home late at 8:30 P.M. & did house work & odd chores until moon. Got in vegetables carrots cabbages and beets up home this aft & fixed at sprinch stone & Chester. Cloudy most of day & rained quite a little drizzle all 3 P.M. Clear as we go to bed. Thanksgiving day today.

Tuesday Oct 11: A lovely warm day warm with wind from the south. Hatt fixed crusher this morning & then got wagon ready to haul pigs. Had early dinner & Hatt was away at 12:45 P.M. with 47 pigs (averaging 205) I fenced around 10 acres pasture east of Hatt. A lovely evening.

Wed Oct 12 - Our Wedding anniversary
I spent most of day at home. Halt cultiva-
gras patches in S.E. 1/4 acres and then fed
cows & did odd jobs rest of day. Mother
Muriel & Walter down here for chicken supper
tonight at 7 P.M. A lovely moonlight night

Thurs Oct 13: Bea & I away to Edm.
at 9:30 this morning & had a very nice
day. Walter did odd jobs and turned some
Russian thistle on C^{ly}. He got home at 1:30 A.M.
Fairly cool but not frosty.

Friday Oct 14: A cool windy day
He cleaned barn and got 4 bags sand clover
out of it. I spent time this aft and then com-
pleted fence & fixed all windows. Muriel &
Mother off to Hollandia this afternoon
Ruby. Walter did odd work this aft. So
windy to burn.

Sat Oct 15: A dark cloudy day
all day but fairly cool. A truck brought

for Hattie while he went to church

this aft too.

Mon Oct 24: Another nice day

here. Then Bea & I away to town
with Muriel in car to have supper
at Oak Lake. Mr Red Roth main
speaker - subject Jean Val Jeant.
Mother kept the baby.

Tues Oct 25: Colder today with
wind from N.W. Hatt & I fenced south
of granary this A.M. & then went down
to Ch (C 50) ~~and~~ with 4 horses and
burned stubble with harrows. Muriel
took Clara Carpenter, Gladys Shinnon
& I home. Drove out to short course
in Oak Lake in car. Cool & windy
tonight.

Wed Oct 26: Warmer today was a very nice day. I disced on C4 with 6 horses this A.M. while Hattie fenced in yard south of low house. Hattie, Arlene & husband Art (Stanup) up home for dinner at noon. Hattie & I down to C4 with 4 horses & harrowed & burned on C50 this aft. - finishing tonight. Stanup down here before they went home to Alberta. A lovely evening.

Thurs Oct 27: I disced south 6 horses this A.M. while Walter fenced in yard. Hattie burned coals this aft (Russian thistle) while I disced & then while I went home & fenced while Hattie disced. I came down here early 5 P.M. & got closer down early

Friday Oct 28: I sawed at Geo Smith's all day from 7 A.M. to 6 P.M. Back up home for dinner. Walter fenced all A.M. & then took Muriel, Arlene, Milne & Bebbie (Humpy) to Brandon in car this aft. Home at 7 P.M. and all of us over to school to Halloween party. Left baby with mother. A lovely evening and a lovely time.

Sat Oct 29: A bright but rather breezy day wind from S.E. Geo Milne & I cleaned up school this A.M. and cleaned pipes. Walter finished discing on C4 at noon and then fenced this aft around low yard. I took team to town this aft & got load of coal (2840) for folks at home. Muriel to town this aft with Gladys Shannon to first aid course. Hazel shot up home tonight for week end.

Sun Oct 30: A lovely day - dry & fairly warm. I went with Mother Muriel & Miss Short to St. David's anniversary services this morning Minister - Mr. White from Timpay Mrs. Parnahan Ida & her husband Mr. ^{Henderson} came up this afternoon and for supper. Dark & cloudy tonight

Tues Nov 1: Raining when we awakened this morning and stayed at it all day. I went up home & helped with chores until 10 A.M. Painted windows in house & hen house out of day. Walter built dog kennel to-day. Threw chores early tonight. Still raining as we go to bed.

Now Oct 31: Raining this morning when awakened & stayed about noon lightly. I cleaned up cellar here & cleaned pipes this morning. Split wood this aft. Walt did odd jobs up home all day and left for St. David's for supper at 5 P.M. & did chores early here & then went up home did Walters chores. Home at 8 P.M.

Wed Nov 2: Did chores in this A.M. and then went up home and fished most of day. Then finished making kennel this aft. & then fished for a time, getting very sick to go to Pool meeting tonight. George Dusker called for a few minutes this aft. Came up home with baby at noon's washed clothes this afternoon. Raining a little tonight. Rain water soaking away considerably although quite a little around.

Thurs Nov 3: A fine - right up but
cloudy & cool this A.M. We painted up some
this P.M. Walter came in from Clev this
aft who was down from the mine
& down here for visit this aft. I went
down to Valley & ran tractor for
Andy Carpenter & Motel & mirel to
town with Clara Carpenter this aft.

Friday Nov 4: A fairly cool day
and cloudy. Went to Carpenter's
with Clark in car & got plowing at
11 A.M. Had to stop at 4 P.M. for
lack of fuel. Walter finished painting
this morning & spread stack bottom this to-day. Walter down this aft. and Bee down
aft. Walter away to Rivers to night to & I up home after supper while Walter went
to see Hon. J. G. Gardner and Mr.
Matthews with A. B. Lawrence

Sat Nov 5: Snowed a little through
the night and froze real hard. A cold
north wind all day to day. I went up
home at 9 P.M. & Walter & I put up a
stack of oats in loft during the day.
Immediately after dinner Walter came
down here with dinner & took back
barley meal we stored in the
cellar up home. A lovely moonlight
night but very frosty.

Sun Nov 6: Bee went to church with folks
this morning while I looked after baby. Mr.
Elliott up home for dinner. Furnace fire lighted
this morning & spread stack bottom this to-day. Walter down this aft. and Bee down
aft. Walter away to Rivers to night to & I up home after supper while Walter went
visiting. A very nice day.

hard frost this b.M. I lit school fire for first
time this morning. Walter & I then got granary

ready for oats. Mel Hart oak at 12.30 P.M.
Bea & I went with him to Kenney &
got 266 bush oats from Mr. Pollock.
Home at 5.15 P.M. & had it unloaded at 6.30
Walter to town in wagon & got load of
souris coal. Doreen stayed with mother
& Meriel this afternoon. A lovely evening
but frosty.

Thurs Nov 8: A very nice day but
rather windy from the west. Walter loaded
coal (souris) this morn. and went to town
in car to Mrs. J. McDonald's funeral
taking Meriel, Uncle Tom, & Annie Milne.
I brought tank & some chops down here in
dinner & then did odd jobs until 5
P.M. A lovely moonlight night but frosty.

Fri Nov 9: A lovely day. Walter
got up stack of sweet clover this A.M.
& I got in load of bedding after
dinner while Walter fixed at stable

windows. I came home early and did
chess & got ready then Doreen Bea & I
up home at 7.15 for supper. Lina & Ann
Saybo, Noru Doherty, Cecil & Marion
all there to celebrate our (Walter & Mine)
birthday anniversary. A lovely time & a
very nice evening.

Thurs Nov 10: Mrs. Stewart & Ding out
this morning and took Isidor & Oak Lake
He cracked some grain for poultry and
then I left took D.T.C. factor to Oak
Lake to Storey Bros to be recharged &
went to Kenney at 1 P.M. with Mel
Hart in truck & brought home cow and
calf at 5 P.M. Cool and cloudy all
day & very dark tonight.

Friday Nov 11: Armistice day and
no school. Up home we got the wagon
ready to gravel. Walter fixed windows
this morning and trimmed trees this aft.

I got a load gravel slop off & put it on the slough grade. Oliver Mowatt came this aft from Winnipeg and will stay a few days. Muriel went up to Ciehl in car & took him out to agricultural contest in Oak Lake in car. Muriel & Oliver set to shovel in barn tonight.

Sat Nov 12: Snowed through the night so did not shovel today. I fixed up windows here & made rooster pen in stable all day. Walter worked at trees all day. Muriel & Oliver to town this aft & then up to Ciehl until 5.30 P.M. Then down here for supper. A cold frosty and somewhat stormy evening.

Sun Nov 13: Cold and frosty again & a strong N. Wind. I went with Walter & Muriel to church & then came

home with Mr. Elliott to have dinner here. Walter here for dinner too. Bed away at 3 P.M. A lovely afternoon & evening.

Mon Nov 14: A very nice day with no wind. 24° below zero this A.M. Big election today and all of us up to vote at 4 P.M. in car taking mess Wilson. Ialt & I put on storm windows and heated up around stable. He put roosters in pen tonight - 34 of them.

Tues Nov 15: Started to snow and storm at 9 A.M. and kept it up most of day. He did odd jobs this morning getting granary cleaned etc. Then cleared wheat all off with fanning mill. Farmer bright and storm abated.

Wed Nov 16: A lovely mild day and melted considerably around noon. I helped Muriel wash this morning & then hauled manure from behind stable & piled it around henhouse. Walter did chores & cleaned out pig pens & I & went to town in car this aft. to get radiator on car fixed - home at 7:15 P.M.

Thurs Nov 17: A fairly cool day with fairly strong wind from S.W. Dad drove this A.M. Walter down to see Muriel this aft to eat wood. Bea up to brother with baby this aft to first aid course meeting. I went up to Cecil this aft in evening & got Bowson ketch grain cleaner.

Friady Nov 18: A nice day with wind

from east. Walter trimmed trees - put on storm windows etc. I went gravelly at 12:5. M and got two loads on way of school. Lena & Bebe ^{came} here for visit at 5 P.M. Mother and Muriel left to Cecil for dinner at noon.

Friday Saturday Nov 19: A rather bitter cold day until 4 P.M. when N.W. wind calmed down a little but still pretty cold tonight. Walter went to town in car early this morning & stayed until 4 P.M. at cattle sale. I did his chores this A.M. and hauled two wads of shalld on road. Bea up home for dinner & home at 4:30 P.M. A fair evening but frosty.

Sun Nov 20: A bitter day but fairly forty. Walter took folks to church in car & Bea went along. We went up home at

3, P.M. got hair cut. Through chores only
Snowing lightly this morning.

Mon Nov 21: A very nice day. I
saw it clear & the did chores etc. till
late. Then went up, hove & spread manure
fixed up truck wagon etc. Father came
down after dinner & helped Mr. Knight
& I load of calves into truck. He then
took my 3 cows up to Father's where
they will stay for the winter. We then
came down here & moved stove into
inside room where we intended to live
for the winter. I did chores up home
& got home fire for supper at 6:30 P.M.

Tues Nov 22: Put 2 loads of chile
on road side off. Father did odd
jobs around all day. Mother & mire
up its Alfreds for visit at noon &

but cool this evening. Maria & Father
went up to Ryerson church in car
to a play given by the missionary society.

Wed Nov 23: A cold dry wind from
N.W. Took out manure up home less but I put
box on wagon. Father out to town to sell
groceries something in car. I went out in
wagon & got load of briquettes (350 lbs)
then picked up home. Dad milking & Father
brought me some wild groceries at 7:30 P.M.

Thurs Nov 24: A fairly nice day
with a light mist snow mist. Did chores
this A.M. and then fixed up doors here
and got things ready for winter. Bought
down pack this aft & took home a load of
~~basket~~ straw while Father unloaded the
load of briquette coal. Home early tonight.

Fri Nov 25: A cold windy day with wind from N.W. Did chores this A.M. while Hattie got barrel from Mrs. Daniels and sheepman arrived. Both of us killed pigs this aft. Left away in car tonight & to bed early - a cold clear night. Mrs. Alex. Smith died this morning.

Sat Nov 26: A fairly nice day. Did chores this A.M. while Hattie & I cut up 2 pigs. I brought 77 lbs of bark down here this A.M. in wagons. Cut it up this aft. and stored in tank here this afternoon. Mrs. Bea, Loren & I went up home at 4 P.M. Hattie & I cleaned wheat for an hour. Bea & I stayed for supper & came home here at 8 P.M. Getting warmer this evening.

Sun Nov 27: A lovely day - sun & snow melting considerably in places. Marin & I left to Ciel in car at 4 P.M. & took Mrs. Ciel & Marin out to dinner.

Mon Nov. 28: Another lovely day and we did some more. Did chores this A.M. and then set up engine & kicker mill. Came home at 12 R.M. & got ready to go to town & Uncle Tom & I went to car to see the pictures over. Hattie went to Carpenter & Son's and saw him bring home tractor. Bea up home this morn & helped Burd wash.

Tues Nov 29: A lovely day bright & warm. melted a little at noon. Marin & Ben left at 10 A.M. in car for Remmey. Took trip into Ciel & arrived home here at 8 P.M. Hattie & I did chores this A.M. & killed a pig this aft. Then came down here at 4 P.M. and took pig up home in crate. A lovely evening. Hattie & Marin out to dinner this evening.

Wed Nov 30: Bea & I up home this morn ^{Cleaned} pigs & hens. Hatt took cleaned wheat down
& killed chickens for truck man ^{morning} & stored it in straw boxes. Hatt away to
morning. Killed 5 for them & had intended to
show tonight.

Dec 1: 11 for us but not in good enough
shape so only did 4 for us. Dint at 3 P.M.
& I then cleaned out stable while Hatt
set up pig. A very mild day with
very moderate temperature & foggy most
of day clearing at times leaving trees
covered with rime.

Thur Dec 1: A mild cloudy misty day
Did chores this A.M. Sold chickens to cream man
Lat 3 A.M. & 1 P.M. Hattis cleaned 25 bush wheat
this aft. while I went up to Cebel & helped
them dig soil. Got down 20 ft before I left.
Uncle T.J. out this A.M. & brought mail

Friday Dec 2: A very mild day but cloudy
and rained at noon. I went up to Cebel
on horseback at 9 A.M. & we finished digging
soil at 1 P.M. I came home then & cleaned out

Sat Dec 3: Another lovely day bright
& warm with fog & frost on the trees. I took
out manure this A.M. & got a load of straw
from K. place. I split wood this aft while
Hatt went to Saco Milnes & saved wood.
Bea & up home to help make a cake this
aft & then both of us walked up to Mrs
Smith with baby for supper. Home at 2
P.M. Had a lovely evening. Hodge on
way home but snow light.
